CANFIELD: Jessica Norris 17 Canfield with the Public Service Commission. 18 MS. FREDERICK: Tina Carson 19 Frederick with the Public Service Commission. 20 MS. ECKERT: Kathryn Eckert for 21 East Kentucky Midstream. 22 MR. BENTLEY: Jason Bentley, East 23 Kentucky Midstream. 24 MS. HONAKER: Allyson Honaker, 25 Kentucky Frontier.

CANFIELD: 10 It's previously been stated that Ο. 11 East Kentucky Midstream does not own any wells; 12 is that correct? 13 As far as I know, yes. Α. 14 So no natural gas-producing wells? Q. 15 Α. Α. 16 And what about the KZ line? 0. 17 Α. The KZ line, which part?
