RESPONSIBLE PARTY: Billy Frasure

Refer to the Answer, paragraph 1. State the terms of the payment agreement with Geneva Trusty.

Response 1. Geneva Trusty entered into a mutually agreed upon payment agreement with Clark Energy on March 17, 2022. The agreement was for Geneva Trusty to make a \$201.25 payment on March 17, 2022, which was paid, and to pay the remaining balance on April 4, 2022 with a lump sum payment. The April 4, 2022 payment was not paid by Geneva Trusty.

Refer to the Answer, paragraph 5. State the terms of the payment agreement with Geneva Trusty and Katrina Trusty.

Response 2. The payment agreement was for \$1,055.19. The \$1055.19 total was comprised of \$888.74 - past due balance of Geneva Trusty that was transferred, and \$166.45 - past due balance of Katrina Trusty. The payment arrangement was for the total amount of \$1055.19 to be paid over a six-month period. During the six-month period, payments outlined in the agreement would have to be made by the third day of each month, and current electric bills would also have to be paid by their respective due dates.

Request 3. Refer to the Answer, paragraph 4. Explain why Katrina Trusty's account would be required to remain current while the balance of Geneva Trusty's account was being paid.

Response 3. When a payment agreement is made between Clark Energy and a consumer for a period that extends beyond the due date of their next electric bill, the requirement is that both the agreed upon payment and future electric bills are to be paid by their due dates. Failure to pay either by its respective due date, results in the consumer defaulting on the payment agreement.

Request 4. Refer to the Answer, paragraph 18.

- a. Identify any provisions of federal or state law or any tariff provisions that prohibit Geneva Trusty from using Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) vouchers in a household for which she is not the electric utility accountholder.
- b. Identify any provisions of federal or state law or any tariff provisions that permit Clark Energy to transfer Geneva Trusty's balance to another account-holder on the basis that she applied LIHEAP vouchers to the other account holder's account.
- c. Identify any other provisions of federal or state law or any other tariff provisions that permit Clark Energy to transfer Geneva Trusty's balance to another account holder.

Response 4a. Clark Energy has no tariff provisions and is unaware of any provisions of federal or state law that prohibit Geneva Trusty from using LIHEAP vouchers in a household for which she is not the electric utility accountholder.

Response 4b. Clark Energy has no tariff provisions and is unaware of any provisions of federal or state law that specifically permits the transfer of Geneva Trusty's balance to Katrina Trusty's account. However, Clark Energy has no tariff provisions which specifically outline the methodology utilized for collection efforts. Clark Energy also respectfully states being unaware of any provisions of federal or state law that prohibits the transfer of Geneva Trusty's balance to

Katrina Trusty's account, once it is established that Geneva Trusty lives in the household with Katrina Trusty.

Clark Energy based this transfer on language found in 807 KAR 5:006 Section 15 (1)(d) which states "a utility shall not be required to furnish new service to a person contracting for service who is indebted to the utility for service furnished or other tariffed charges until that person contracting for service has paid his indebtedness." Clark Energy is aware that the account which the balance was transferred to is in Katrina Trusty's name rather than Geneva Trusty. Nevertheless, based on the fact that LIHEAP vouchers were issued to Geneva Trusty for assistance with Katrina Trusty's account, Clark Energy takes the position that this establishes a co-ownership on the account which justifies the transfer. Clark Energy respectfully states that the balance transfer was made in good faith on behalf of its membership to assist in the collection of past due accounts.

Should you notify us in writing within thirty (30) days after your receipt of this letter that you dispute the amount set forth herein, we will attempt to verify the debt more specifically.



GENERAL INFORMATION

KILOWATT HOUR (kWh) - Base unit of electric energy used to measure amount of electricity used. One kWh equals 1,000 watts of electricity used for one hour.

FUEL ADJUSTMENT - The fuel adjustment charge/credit is a cost recovery mechanism ordered by the Kentucky Public Service Commission, which allows monthly increases or decreases in fuel costs to be included on your bill. The charge fluctuates based upon weather, power outages or situations that impact our energy supplier's price for fuel or cost to buy power. The fuel adjustment is calculated by multiplying the kwh usage by the fuel adjustment factor.

FACILITY CHARGE - A fixed monthly charge for the cost of having electric service facilities in place and available for use.

ENVIRONMENTAL SURCHARGE - The environmental surcharge covers the costs incurred by power suppliers to meet government-mandated reductions in emmission levels.

NEIGHBOR TO NEIGHBOR PROGRAM - An opportunity for members to contribute funds to provide assistance to needy Clark Energy members. The funds will be administered by Kentucky River Foothills and Gateway Community Services. You may make a donation by checking the box on the front of the stub; write in the amount of your donation and add that amount to your electric payment. You may also elect to make monthly donations; the amount you designate will appear on your electric bill and be added to your total due. If you are interested in contributing monthly, please call our office for an authorization form.

AUTOMATIC BANK DRAFT SERVICE - Clark Energy offers automatic bank draft to pay your monthly electric bill. This service will save you time, postage, check costs and trips to our office. You will have the security of knowing that your bill will always be paid on time - even when you are away from home. 


