COMMISSION STAFF'S FIFTH REQUEST FOR INFORMATION
TO WESTERN FLEMING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

Western Fleming County Water District (Western Fleming District), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested is due on February 27, 2026. The Commission directs Western Fleming District to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085¹ regarding filings with the Commission. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the question to which the response is made and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the

person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Western Fleming District shall make timely amendment to any prior response if Western Fleming District obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect or incomplete when made or, though correct or complete when made, is now incorrect or incomplete in any material respect.

For any request to which Western Fleming District fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Western Fleming District shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied and scanned material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, Western Fleming District shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. Refer to Western Fleming District's Request to Use Surcharge Funds filed December 16, 2025, loan agreement on page 7, which indicates the principal amount is \$146,000. As stated in the opening Order, Western Fleming District was approved to charge its surcharge until \$105,120 was collected. If the expenditure is approved, explain

how Western Fleming District plans to pay the remaining loan payments after the surcharge funds have been exhausted.

2. Refer to Western Fleming District's response to Staff's Fourth Request for Information, filed January 10, 2025, (Staff's Fourth Request) Question 1, Item J. Provide an update on whether Western Fleming District still plans to seek a declaratory order for this project.

3. Refer to Western Fleming District's response to Staff's Fourth Request, Question 2.

a. Refer to Item C. Confirm that using the entire surcharge collection for meter replacements means Western Fleming District will be unable to finance the proposed line replacement project with any surcharge funds. If not confirmed, explain the response.

b. Refer to Item D. State whether there have been any updates from Kentucky Infrastructure Authority (KIA) regarding funding for the proposed line replacement project. If so, provide the status of the funding.
