We live in the Moon Lake subdivision in Scott County Kentucky. We are customers of Bluegrass Water Utility Operating Company for our sewer service. Bluegrass Water has proposed a rate increase of 694%.

We understand that a rate increase may be in order but lets be realistic, 100 % increase is a more realistic real world increase. Lots of people live on a fixed income and a 694% increase in any bill would be a major burden . At a time with groceries and fuel cost going into record highs we don't need a rate increase of 694%.

We would ask the Public Service Commission to look at this rate increase and remember that this increase will have major impact on real people.

I am sending this letter to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort Kentucky 40602. Written request for intervention needs to be received at the Public Service Commission within 30 days of the company filing for the rate increase which was filed on February 27.

I received a letter from a lawyer representing the Bluegrass Water Utility Operating Company. Their legal counsel has ask the Public Service Commission to deny the request of intervention from myself and eight other listed individuals from Georgetown and six other communities in Kentucky. They also ask the Public Service Commission to deny all other customers of Bluegrass Water.

I filed the above concern with the Public Service Commission about a proposed rate increase of over 600 % on our residential sewer bill! Today I received a letter where the legal counsel filed for the Bluegrass Water Operating Company, LLC.

I am not a lawyer but in short they basically are saying that we their customers do not

have any interest in this rate increase, which is absolutely wrong.

The Public Service Commission has a mission statement on their website and it states. The mission of the KPSC is to foster the provision of safe and reliable service at a reasonable price to the customers of jurisdiction utilities. While providing for financial stability of those utilities by setting fair and just rates , and supporting their operational competence by overseeing regulated activities.

The key point that I took away from the mission statement is that the Commission will lookout for the people of the state of Kentucky while keeping the interest of the utilities in

mind as well.

I again ask the Kentucky Public Service Commission to intervene with this over excessive rate increase of 694% . I will agree that a rate increase is needed to maintain the sewer system . A realistic rate increase of 100% is agreeable .
