Comments: I am a farmer in Ballard county and also live in the area where the proposed site is for this solar farm. We are opposed to any solar farm in our county. My son Clint Ross purchased a new home at 3526 Gage Road and closed on the loan on January 13 2023. Exactly two weeks later we found out there is going to be this Song Sparrow solar farm directly behind his new home. Apparently some people did not receive a notice of a public meeting. We later did receive a letter dated April 23 2023 stating Song Sparrow would be submitting its application to you the siting board for certificate of construction. Then we found out just recently another solar company Bright Night has leased farm land across the road from the house for another solar farm. We are drowning in a solar invasion in Ballard county. I would also like to mention that one of the two members on our local siting board has his farm leased to a solar company for a solar farm. Is this not a conflict of interest? I think I heard someone say in the hearing today that a bald eagles nest could not be within two miles of a solar farm. I can show you several of them in or near these proposed solar farms.
