

Dear Public Service Commission,

This letter is in regard to the proposed price changes by Cunningham Water District. I understand that inflation is pushing prices up for everyone, and that theirs may have to be adjusted. I would ask that the water being provided be improved however. When my wife and I moved in the house in July 2021, we started having to use city water. After working in the heat for about three days, we both could smell chlorine coming through my skin in my sweat. Since then we have filtered our water in a pitcher, and then moved to bottled water. My point of view simply is, if we should have to pay more for the water, could someone please regulate the quality of the water enough that it would be suitable to drink. I am not opposed to a slight, 2.5% total price raise or so, if that would be permissible, but I am asking that the water be ~~so~~ improved before, or during the price raise. Thank you for reading this note, and I hope I have not offended anyone.
