ORDER

On January 30, 2023, Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc. (Columbia Kentucky) filed its proposed Gas Cost Adjustment (GCA) report to be effective March 1, 2023. Columbia Kentucky's previous GCA rate was approved in Case No. 2022-00360.¹

LEGAL STANDARD

The Commission's standard of review for GCR rates is well settled as stated in KRS 278.274(1):

In determining whether proposed natural gas utility rates are just and reasonable, the commission shall review the utility's gas purchasing practices. The commission may disallow any costs or rates which are deemed to result from imprudent purchasing practices on the part of the utility.

Further, the utility has the burden to prove the rates are just and reasonable and the Commission may reduce the purchased gas component of the utility's rates or the rates charged by and affiliated company to the extent the amount is deemed to be unjust or unreasonable.²

DISCUSSION

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Columbia Kentucky's report includes revised rates designed to pass on to its customers its expected change in gas costs. Columbia Kentucky's report sets out an Expected Gas Cost (EGC) of \$5.3347 per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$2.2403 per Mcf from its previous EGC of \$7.5750 per Mcf. Columbia Kentucky's report sets out a rate for Banking and Balancing Service of \$0.0332 per Mcf. Columbia Kentucky's report sets out a total supplier Refund Adjustment (RA) of (\$0.3491) per Mcf, which is no change from its previous total RA.3 Columbia Kentucky's report sets out a current quarter Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) of \$0.7125 per Mcf. Columbia Kentucky's total ACA is \$2.0256 per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$0.1892 per Mcf from its previous total ACA of \$2.2148 per Mcf. Columbia Kentucky's report sets out a Balancing Adjustment (BA) of \$0.0170 per Mcf, which is an increase of \$0.0277 per Mcf from its previous BA of (\$0.0107) per Mcf. Columbia Kentucky's report sets out no Special Agency Service (SAS) refund adjustment. Columbia Kentucky's report sets out a Performance-Based Rate (PBR) Adjustment of \$0.3314 per Mcf.

Based on the calculations above, the Commission finds that Columbia Kentucky's GCA is \$7.3596 per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$2.4018 per Mcf from the previous GCA of \$9.7614 per Mcf. The Commission further finds that the rates as proposed by Columbia

Kentucky and set forth in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just and reasonable and are approved for billing with the final meter readings beginning on and after March 1, 2023.

For the purpose of transparency and to maintain a record of information for future use, the Commission finds that Columbia Kentucky shall submit all invoices it receives along with its monthly usage report for each month of the reporting period when it files its future GCA rate reports. As ordered by the Commission in Case No. 2018-00150,⁴ Columbia Kentucky's future GCA reports shall include an electronic version containing supporting calculations in Excel spreadsheet format with all formulas, columns, and rows unprotected and fully accessible. Should Columbia Kentucky purchase sustainable natural gas from a renewable source during the reporting period of any future GCA reports then the supplier, cost, and amount must be documented in its cover letter to the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ODERED that:

- The rates proposed by Columbia Kentucky and set forth in the Appendix to this Order are approved for billing with the final meter readings beginning on and after March 1, 2023.
- 2. Columbia Kentucky shall submit all invoices it receives along with its monthly usage reports for each month of the reporting period when it files its future GCA rate reports.

- 3. Columbia Kentucky's future GCA reports shall include an electronic version containing supporting calculations in Excel spreadsheet format with all formulas, columns, and rows unprotected and fully accessible.
- 4. Within 20 days of the date of service of this Order, Columbia Kentucky shall file with this Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets setting out the rates approved herein and reflecting that they were approved pursuant to this Order.
 - 5. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
