ORDER

On November 20, 2023, the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by and through the Office of Rate Intervention (Attorney General) and Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. (KIUC) (jointly, Attorney General/KIUC) filed a motion seeking to allow virtual participation of Attorney General/KIUC's witnesses, Lane Kollen, Stephen Baron, and Richard Baudino, at the November 28, 2023 through December 6, 2023 hearing scheduled in this case.

As a basis for its motion, Attorney General/KIUC stated that its witnesses have filed the direct testimony on October 2, 2023, and that the witnesses responded to all data requests in an October 30, 2023 filing. The Attorney General/KIUC stated that Mr. Baron has multiple scheduling conflicts during the week of November 27-December 2, 2023, as he is scheduled to testify in three separate proceedings in three separate states. Concerning Mr. Kollen, Attorney General/KIUC states that he is scheduled to testify in hearings in another state the following week.

Based upon the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Attorney General/KIUC has not established good cause to allow Mr. Kollen to participate virtually. The Order establishing the procedural schedule issued by the Commission on July 20, 2023, set forth the expectation that witnesses shall participate in person at the hearing.<sup>1</sup> Mr. Kollen will be available and is expected to testify in person. As to Mr. Baron and Mr. Baudino, although they sponsored responses to information requests and are thus subject to the same expectation set forth in the Commission's July 20, 2023 Order, the Commission finds that Attorney General/KIUC has established good cause to grant the motion; therefore, Mr. Baron and Mr. Baudino should be allowed to appear virtually at the hearing.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Attorney General/KIUC's motion is denied in part and granted in part.
2. Lane Kollen shall participate in person at the November 28, 2023 through December 6, 2023 hearing.
3. Stephen Baron may participate virtually in the November 28, 2023 through December 6, 2023 hearing.
4. Richard Baudino may participate virtually in the November 28, 2023 through December 6, 2023 hearing.
5. Attorney General/KIUC shall notify Commission Staff of the party or parties that will be participating virtually pursuant to this Order within one day of the date of service of this Order.

6. Commission Staff shall contact the participants with instructions for participating remotely.
