ORDER

This matter arises upon the motion of Shelby Energy Cooperative, Inc., (Shelby Energy) filed November 6, 2023, for an extension of time until 20 days after a decision on Shelby Energy's motion for rehearing is entered to file its revised tariffs in the above-styled case. In support of its motion, Shelby Energy explained that if it is successful on any of its issues raised in its motion for rehearing of an Order approving a rate increase for Shelby Energy. Shelby Energy asserted that, because rates may change due to issues raised in its motion for rehearing, that filing the tariff prior to a decision on the rehearing motion will cause confusion for its members and may appear as if Shelby Energy received two rate increases. Shelby Energy stated that it does not plan to put new rates into effect until an Order is issued on its motion for rehearing.

Based on the motion and case record, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Shelby Energy has shown good cause based on avoiding the appearance of multiple rate increases and because the utility will not place the rates approved in the October 17, 2023 Order¹ into effect until an Order is issued on Shelby


Energy's motion for rehearing. Therefore, the Commission further finds that the motion for extension of time should be granted until 20 days after an Order has been entered in the motion for rehearing. Additionally, based on Shelby Energy's statements in its motion, no new rates will be put into effect until an Order is issued on Shelby Energy's motion for rehearing.


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The November 6, 2023 motion of Shelby Energy for an extension of time in which to file its revised tariffs is granted.

2. Within 20 days of the date of service of the Order in Shelby Energy's motion for rehearing, Shelby Energy shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, new tariff sheets setting forth the rates and charges approved herein and reflecting its effective data and that it was authorized by this Order.
