<u>ORDER</u>

On November 20, 2023, Angela Christine Douglas filed a complaint alleging that Kentucky Utilities Company (KU) improperly applied Advanced Meter Infrastructure (AMI) opt-out charges to her account.

By Order dated December 20, 2023, the Commission found that Ms. Douglas failed to establish a *prima facie* case pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 20(4)(a) because her complaint did not state why KU's assessment of these charges was improper under law or tariff. The Commission permitted Ms. Douglas to file an amended complaint within 20 days of service of the Order. This time period has passed since Ms. Douglas was served with that Order and she has not filed an amended complaint. The Commission finds that this matter should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The complaint is dismissed with prejudice.
- 2. The case is closed and shall be removed from the docket.
