

Kentucky-American Water Company provides notice that it is filing with the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") in Case No. 2023-00030 a request for an increase in the amount of its Qualified Infrastructure Program Rider ("QIP Rider"). The filing will be made no later than March 1, 2023 with a request for the new amount to be effective on July 1, 2023. The amount as of February 14, 2023 is 4.81% and calculations herein are based on that amount. The proposed increase is an addition of 3.80% for a cumulative proposed amount of 8.61%. The QIP Rider applies to Residential, Commercial, Industrial, Other Public Authority, Sales for Resale, and Public and Private Fire Service and Hydrant customers. The additional revenue to be requested in this QIP Rider filing is \$3,746,023. Average usage, in hundreds of gallons, for each customer class to which the QIP Rider applies is: Residential: 39; Commercial: 342; Industrial: 9,713; Other Public Authority: 1,205; Sales for Resale: 18,720; Public and Private Fire Service and Hydrant: 0. The effect on the current average monthly bill for each customer class to which the increased fee applies is: Residential: \$1.42 (3.80%); Commercial: \$7.33 (3.80%); Industrial: \$163.43 (3.80%); Other Public Authority: \$26.51 (3.80%); Sales for Resale: \$206.88 (3.80%); Public Fire Hydrant: \$1.35 (3.80%); Private Fire Service: \$3.02 (3.80%); and Private Fire Hydrant: \$2.91 (3.80%). NOTICE

Kentucky-American Water Company provides notice of its requested adjustment of the Kentucky River Authority withdrawal fee. The fees contained in this notice are the fees to be proposed by Kentucky-American Water Company to the Public Service Commission no later than March 1, 2023 to be effective on March 31, 2023. The current fee, which applies to Residential, Commercial, Industrial, Other Public Authority and Sales for Resale customers, is \$0.0275 per 100 gallons. The requested fee, which applies to the same customer classes as the current fee, is \$0.0288 per 100 gallons. For all customer classes to which the fee applies, the requested fee is a decrease of \$0.0010, or -3.64%, per 100 gallons. Average usage, in hundreds of gallons, for each customer class to which the fee applies is: Residential: 39; Commercial: 342; Industrial: 9,713; Other Public Authority: 1,205; and Sales for Resale: 18,720. The effect on the average monthly bill for each customer class to which the decreased fee applies is: Residential: -\$0.04; Commercial: -\$0.34; Industrial: -\$9.71; Other Public Authority: -\$1.21; and Sales for Resale: -\$18.72. Customers in Eastern Rockcastle County are not charged the fee, therefore are excluded from the calculation.
