
Pursuant to an Order issued on August 16, 2023, an informal conference (IC) was conducted on August 17, 2023. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The purpose of the IC was to discuss the proposed project and alternatives presented in the application in Case No. 2023-00040.

- Discuss alternatives presented in the CPCN
- Alternative #1: line through Johns Creek-Belfry-Stone
 - Single cap bank at Johns Creek station to address the 2020 PJM requirement
 - To fix baseline violations and an expansion on the original proposal
 - Rebuild yellow line between Stone and Sprigg
 - Rebuild 46 kV to a 69 kV
- Alternative #2: keep adding capacitor banks and various places on the lines in the area and the difficulties that solution would present
- Kentucky Power presented a map that was part of PJM approval process that will be attached to this memo filing.
- Kentucky Power indicated that it would file supplemental testimony to support its application.

There being no further discussion, the IC was then adjourned.
