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### <u>ORDER</u>

On April 14, 2025, Kentucky Power Company (Kentucky Power) filed a motion for an extension until March 20, 2027, to file its next Integrated Resource Plan (IRP). As grounds for the extension, Kentucky Power stated that the Commission Staff Report in this matter has not been issued.<sup>1</sup> Kentucky Power noted it will need time to review those comments, investigate potential resources and as the federal environmental regulatory climate continues to evolve, time to evaluate the resulting impacts to better inform the IRP resource selection process.<sup>2</sup> Kentucky Power also cited to several examples the Commission has previously allowed an extension of time to file its IRP.<sup>3</sup>

Having considered the motion and the status of the current matter, the Commission finds that Kentucky Power has provided good cause to grant its motion for an extension of time. The Commission acknowledges that the Commission Staff Report has not been issued. In addition, the Commission agrees that Kentucky Power should have adequate time to review the report and then prepare its next IRP. The Commission finds that

granting an extension no later than March 20, 2027, should allow Kentucky Power to present a thorough and detailed IRP.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Kentucky Power's motion is granted.
- 2. Kentucky Power shall file its next IRP no later than March 20, 2027.
