**RE:** Informal Conference of September 10, 2024

Pursuant to a Staff Notice issued on August 22, 2024, an informal conference (IC) was conducted on September 10, 2024. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The purpose of the IC was to discuss the requirements of the monthly surcharge activity and water loss reports. McKinney Water District (McKinney District) stated it would file the July reports soon in order to get caught up.

McKinney District had its engineers, AGE Engineering, available for the informal conference. Taylor Stamper, utility inspector for the Commission, asked a few questions regarding the QIIP filed December 26, 2023 and McKinney District's response to Commission Staff's First Request for Information. McKinney District clarified that it seeks to add a master meter between the Ottenheim Pump Station and the Stanford system because currently, the Mag Meter located at the Ottenheim Pump Station is not tested and there is no way to test it, as it only operates when the pump operates. The proposed new master meter would allow McKinney District to more accurately read and calculate water usage and water loss from this location. Commission Staff informed McKinney District that the QIIP was still in the review process. Commission Staff also reminded the utility that, before spending any funds from the water loss surcharge account, it needed to request permission from the Commission and provide supporting documentation and invoices in order to receive reimbursement.

There being no further discussion, the IC was then adjourned.
