Multiple complaints have been made since the start of this project and the chairman has stopped contact all together. The condition of the storm drain is documented extensively and has been noted throughout the duration of this project. Professional opinion from a conversation with the Project Foreman of the company doing the work even acknowledged that the drains are not acceptable and the chairman refused to allow me to be present to raise concerns to the project engineer. Since then the contractors have left and the job has been signed off on. There has been obvious impairments to other portions of the street, backed up by before and after video, this leads me to believe a personal agenda of refusing to repair the portion that directly affects me and my property negatively.

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
Due to the slip pour work performed by the water
