State the nature of your concern: Case 2024-00010 The proposed water increase to Morgan County's residents, businesses and schools is more than excessive, 41% at one time after two increases already in the last 3 years. I am personally a water customer, but I am also the finance officer for the school system in Morgan County. Aside from the impact this will have on my personal bill, the school system will be heavily impacted as we have the larger meters, going from 900+ to 1300+ on a basic bill is quite hefty on taxpayer dollars. Schools are already seeing increases on all expenses, but again 41% after two other increases in the last few years is excessive. I also would like to ask for consideration of our elderly population in this rural community. Making ends meet for many of them is already dire, this is another

burden after two previous increases in this economy. I respectfully ask that the PSC look into all areas of the finances to ensure the customers of Morgan County Water District are paying for the proper water service and not excessive spending on vehicles (even if leased), trips, and staff. Please reject this increase.
