PUBLIC NOTICE

STMO Bn, LLC, is proposing to develop and construct the Starfire Solar Project, a 210-megawatt solar electric generating facility to be located in Knott, Breathitt, and Perry Counties, Kentucky. The proposed solar project will be situated on approximately 2,015 acres of land, with an address of 620 Balls Fork Road, Ary, Kentucky 41712. The project will consist of photovoltaic panels and their associated racking systems, inverters, collection system, project substation, and other equipment.

STMO Bn, LLC, is required to file an application with the Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting ("Board") to obtain a certificate of construction for the proposed electric generating facility. This filing will occur in the coming weeks. This proposed construction is subject to approval by the Board, which can be reached at P.O. Box 615, 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602-0615, or via phone at (502) 564-3940.

A person who wishes to become a party to a proceeding before the Board may, by written motion filed no later than thirty (30) days after the application has been submitted, request leave to intervene. A party may, upon written motion filed no later than thirty (30) days after an application has been filed, request the Board to schedule an evidentiary hearing at the offices of the Public Service Commission. A request for a local public hearing or local public information meeting shall be made by at least three (3) interested persons who reside in the county in which the plant is proposed to be located. The request shall be made in writing and shall be filed within thirty (30) days following the filing of a completed application. 042:10/10:1t:pd
