I am 95 years of age and have enjoyed the beauty of Barren County all of my life. I am writing to ask you to decline the proposed solar development on agricultural land for many reasons.

First I have a particular reason for asking you to cancel this project. My brother-in-law, Howard Scott Magers, U.S. Navy was killed during WWII at Pearl Harbor. His remains were interred in the Merry Oaks Methodist Church Cemetery in May 2021. He died aboard the USS Oklahoma.

And while the community has changed, adding these commercial solar parks with the added heat, the runoff water, the commercial look of each tract will forever destroy the beauty and charm of this beautiful community.

These solar panels will be less than ½ mile from the cemetery. There should never be a solar producing utility company so close to a church and cemetery where heroes are buried. These panels are enclosing around many houses and that simply isn't right.

I also ask for your support of Mammoth Cave and the protected species in the cave. I used to wade in Sinking Creek. Please protect it and deny this project.
