RE: The Maps from Wood Duck Solar - Which one is the final?

Request the Siting Board to rectify the failure of Wood Duck to provide accurate and complete project information on maps for public review.

Wood Duck solar displayed 2 maps at the informational meetings in Barren County, which were held after the project was approved by the local planning commission on December 18, 2023. At these two meetings, community members were told it was a "done deal" and nothing could be changed. At this time, the public was unaware of the setback and lot variances approved by Barren County planning.

We believe the 2 maps that the public has had the opportunity to review are not the final maps and Wood Duck has failed to disclose pertinent information that the public needs to know and have an opportunity to comment on.

The developer did not provide any handouts or maps to citizens who attended the information sessions.

Map 1: Overall Site Plan, dated July 14, 2023 states 25 Inverters. It only has 27 parcels and the locations of the inverters are not identified. Application filed with the siting board says 28 parcels. Which is it? Where is the 28th parcel and was it submitted for review?

Additionally, this map failed to provide the locations for the underground battery storage system locations. Map fails to provide road names and is not ADA compliant.

This map was prepared 6 months prior to the variances granted by Barren County planning on December 18, 2023 How could they have known 6 months previously that the variances would be approved?

Barren County planning regulations allow a 50' set back on the front, 20' in the back and 10' on the sides (50-20-10). The map states "non-participating **parcel** setback of 50' It does not clarify if this is 50' from the road or is it 50' feet for all sides?

The map also states "county and state road setback of 100'. Yet, they have a 50' setback approved by the planning commission. Which one is accurate?

The map states that "A non-participating occupied structure setback is 300'." Is this 300' on the front, back and sides? This needs to be clarified.

Residents would like the 300' setback to be changed to 1,000 feet setbacks on all sides and request that all structures with animals/birds/bees be treated as an occupied structure and be respectful with a 1,000 feet setback as well, since they are occupied by beings that are the livelihood for local farmers.

In May 2025, Barren County Fiscal Court updated the planning regulations and required a 1,000 feet setbacks and residents believe this to be a more equitable. The 50-20-10 was approved in 2019 and the public hearings were not well advertised. A total of 7 people attended the two meetings. So, when Wood Duck came along, there were no hearings on the 50-20-10, just a variance to the 20-10 to zero which was approved on December 18, 2023.

Map 2: Parcel Map, dated June 15, 2023 states the same verbiage as the Overall Site Plan for distances. This map was prepared 7 months before the variances were approved and the measurements/setbacks do not match what was approved by BC Planning Commission.

Neither map addresses the zero lot variance granted by the Commission on December 18, 2023, nor address the 50-20-10 setbacks.

Map is so small, it is hard to read and not ADA compliant.

Map 3 Preliminary Landscape Plan with no date.

It does not provide the locations of the 35 inverters as stated in the application.

Additionally, this map does not indicate that ALL road frontage will be screened with a landscape buffer.

Map doesn't provide road names.

Additionally, all 3 maps failed to provide clear information as to what parcels will be in Edmonson County. The <u>Critical Issues Analysis</u> which included maps, but only included 25 parcels, included data on Edmonson County, but Wood Duck has failed to identify the properties in Edmonson County. This map was presented to the Barren County Planning Commission, but it seems to have omitted pertinent information which the public has not had the opportunity to review.

Therefore, the <u>Critical Issues Analysis</u> did not include all of the parcels for environmental assessment and therefore, this study is incomplete.

Wood Duck/Geenex stated in the Notice of Intent to the Siting Board in November 2024 and I quote, #5. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:110, Section 2(2)€, the Subdivision Regulations of Barren County, Kentucky, require the following minimum setbacks for a ground-mounted Solar Energy System (SES): 50-foot front yard setback; 10-foot side yard setback; and 20-foot rear yard setback.

In the application submitted to the siting board in May 2025, Wood Duck states there will be **35** inverters; yet the maps only state **25**. Again, the locations of the inverters are not noted on the maps and have not been provided to the public for comment and review.

In the application, page 5, if references "above ground water storage tanks." How many? What size? Purpose? Where will they be located? They are not on any map.

Therefore, the maps they have provided to the public are incorrect and they have deprived the public the opportunity to review and comment. The public has a right to know where each inverter and battery storage unit will be located and this information has not been provided.

Additionally, KRS 278.706 (2)(b) " states that a map showing the distance of the proposed site from residential neighborhood, the nearest residential structures, schools, and public and private parks that are located within a two (2) mile radius' of the proposed facility."

This map has not been provided, because this project has 27 separate scattered sites that meander nearly 20 miles throughout the community. So, to take one snap shot is not an accurate depiction of the project design.

These maps need to be provided as there is an Amish school which has been omitted from Wood Duck's consideration.

Therefore, we are requesting a map amendment be prepared and provided for public review and comment, pursuant to KRS 100.347 (2).

Community's Solar Panel Concerns



We own over 300 + acres in the proposed solar development area in Barren County. We also lease @650 acres on several tracks in the proposed area. We currently lease some of this land from four of the participating landowners who have signed on to become solar developments, so we will lose our leases if this is approved. Some of this is prime agricultural land that we are leasing and their decision to "sign on" will destroy our farming land base in Barren County.

As farmers of nearly 1,000 acres, we contribute significantly to the farming community of Barren County which is a top agricultural community for milk and cattle production in the state. We support various farm related companies through our farming and are good neighbors to adjoining farms.

We understand "it's greed" and that is why the landowners have signed on. It's an easy check which takes farmland out of production. However, farming is our way of life and we are committed to what we do. We help feed America. We are concerned with the potential of losing the leased land, but also concerned with the contaminants in the environment that will affect our land. The increased heat, the hazardous run-off and the disruption of farm life is simply wrong for our community.

As we earn a portion of our income from the leased land in this proposed development, Wood Duck should compensate us for the potential loss of income over the duration of the project. We have worked this land and prepared it for our crops and this is a huge loss to us and those who benefit from crop production.

Additionally, we strongly object to the setback variances requested by the developer. The road sides should have more than a 50-foot setback – should be 1,000 feet at least. Additionally, the 10-foot side

and 20-foot rear variances will create an undue hardship on all of the homes, farms, structures that are within this project. They too should be a minimum of 1,000 feet.

We were approached by Wood Duck and offered big bucks. We are not for sale. We love our land. We love our country and we want to preserve Barren County for future generations. Please deny this project.

PSC and Citing Board:

Our property is adjacent to a large section of the proposed development in Barren County. We raise grow crops (corn and soybeans) on @300 acres and we do not want the surrounding farmland put under solar panels creating additional heat, run-off water and toxins in the soil. We own beautiful woodlands filled with nature and we do not want any sections of the beautiful habitat destroyed by the proposed scattered-site development.

We believe this project was approved in error by local government. Apparently our zoning didn't realize the commercial impact of this development and have refused to have conversations allowing residents to be heard. These are commercial solar facilities which will surround residences, farms, children, crops and animals.

We have many concerns including potential solar panel fires which can spread into neighboring crops and can destroy our food sources, woodlands, homes, and contaminate water. The toxins will fall on farmland which is grazed by cattle. The release of toxins in the air will fall on our crops and could ultimately be consumed by you, the consumer. These are "right next door."

We are extremely close to the Mammoth Cave watershed and we know there are numerous underlying water channels leading to Mammoth Cave and Green River. Mammoth Cave is home to many endangered species and this project could endanger them. We know there are many endangered and threatened species within the project area and do not trust the developer to take adequate steps to protect.

We have serious health concerns about this project from the contaminates in the panels, the added heat and noise, the increased glare, and damages to our ecosystem.

We know this project will hurt many farmers who lease land in this area.

We are also opposed to the setbacks proposed by this project. We object to the 50-foot road frontage, 10-foot side and 20-foot rear variances as submitted in the Notice of Intent filed with the PSC. All of these should be a minimum of 1,000 feet. The mitigation "efforts" of planting shrubs is an effort of little significance as they will die without water, nutrients and care. This project will destroy many acres of trees, habitat and farmland. Hold this developer accountable, if it must be. Best option is to have them find land outside of farmland.

We are adamantly opposed to this **as a property owner with adjacent property.** Please cancel this project and save **our** farm.

Our property is adjacent to a large section of the proposed development in Barren County. The solar development is directly across the road AND on one side of our home.

We are completed opposed to this development and had no knowledge off this development until it was already approved by our local planning and zoning. We attended the information sessions at Cave City and were completely ignored with our concerns and requests. Therefore, we are writing to you with hope that you will listen to our concerns.

First, we are concerned that this is going to be within a few feet of our home on the side. We were not advised that planning had granted variances of 50-20-10-0 feet and we had no input. ZERO.

It is absolutely abhorrent that we will be looking out our front door at a 300-400 acre field of panels and we had no vice in the decision. The glare from this and the light pollution, the runoff water, and the increased heat is not welcomed.

We are concerned with fire potential and it spreading. WE do not have sufficient water lines (most are 4 inch) in the project area to support commercial properties as stipulated in county building codes which require a 6 inch water line for a commercial property. We know the fires can spread quickly and this puts us more at risk being so close to our home. It should be a minimum of 2,000 feet from our home where we are raising our baby boy.

Our baby boy will not have the luxury of fields to explore, birds to observe, deer to chase. He will instead face the detrimental decisions of greedy neighbors who made decisions in spite of friendship and respect for others. And while we understand KY government is encouraging "green energy" our experience in the health industry refutes many of the claims and we will now live with the fear of the unknown and what we do know and the risk this will create for OUR boy.

We are concerned with the analysis Wood Duck submitted about the glare. We disagree with their conclusion that the reflection will only be a few minutes because of the way the sun sets in this area and the rotation of the panels. It will be directly in our front windows, but more importantly, it will be blinding to motorists, Amish buggies, and school buses full of children and all of our neighbors, whom we care about.

We raise show chickens and goats. This project stands to damage our animals should a glass panel break and shatter, leaving glass shards and the dangerous metals on the ground that can quickly be transferred to our property by runoff and rain – both of which will be tremendously impacted by this proposed development. Again, it should be at least a 2,000 feet setback.

We estimate approximately a mile (maybe a mile and ½) of road frontage of the solar panels across the roads. We are aware of Wood Duck's proposal to plant Arborvitaes along the road frontage. We do not approve of this selection as they are not native to Kentucky and are prone to disease and bagworms which are deadly to our show chickens. We want to have a variety of trees, plants and bushes that will offer a pleasing frontage to conceal all of their panels. We want walnut, oak, maple, cherry, dogwoods, tulip trees, poplar trees and a variety of native bushes, flowers and wildflowers to help mitigate the hundreds of acres they are destroying and the habitats they have eliminated.

We are concerned with the decline in our property values. We do not believe the assessments by Kirkland and Wood Duck. They stated that solar panels AFFECT nothing...not houses, farmland, vacant residences. We know this isn't true.

Our mother/mother-in-law is a real estate agent and has assured us that we will lose significant money on our property because of the solar panels. The fact these are commercial solar plants with chainlink fencing creates an industry and commercial look to the area. It will destroy the farmland and reduce all farmer's and all owner's equity and we have had no voice in any of these decisions.

We have one additional outbuilding and would request that it too be included in a 2,000 feet setback.

Commercial solar developments do not belong in residential areas and we ask that you stop this project. We are adamantly opposed to this as a property owner with adjacent property. Please cancel this project and save our farm.

My farm property is adjacent to a large section of the proposed development in Barren County. I lease this land for agriculture; however, I purchased it with the intent of building my retirement oasis in the country where wildlife roams and the Sandhill Crane are abundant.

I was told by neighbors who ARE participants in this project that it wasn't going to be completed. They withheld information and I found out after it was approved. I voiced concerns to Wood Duck, but they failed to address my concerns presenting a condescending attitude.

My concerns include their incorrect assessment of property values. Kirkland Appraisals LLC stated "there is no impact on home values due to abutting or adjoining a solar farm; as well as, no impact to abutting or adjacent vacant residential or agricultural land." I'm not sure where Mr. Kirkland pulled these numbers, but they obviously do not apply to a 27-track scattered site development in residential areas. This area is tax assessed as farmland and residential. It should remain as such. To build a commercial solar plant, and FENCE it, within 10 feet of my property line WILL significantly reduce the value of my property and WILL reduce my quality of life; and ultimately prohibit my goal or retiring to Barren County.

As it stands today, my property has significant run-off water due to the topography of adjoining neighbor's property. This will only get worse.

No one has talked to me about how this will be corrected. There are trees and vegetation which help to some extent, but when this is removed, the run-off will only increase. Solar Panels do not absorb water and if the panel are in a horizontal position when the rains fall, the velocity of the water will increase, landing on soil which has been disturbed and will only increase in

volume and strength as it flows thru the crops on my field, washing away the seeds, nutrients and soil. My income will be severely affected by this ill-conceived plan.

I am also concerned about the community and the disruption to the agricultural community. Solar developments should be placed in areas which do not adversely affect farmland and the farming community.

This development impacts my land and my income.

I do not believe this project was approved correctly. I do not believe it has been handled appropriately. It has been concealed from the community for reasons still unknown. The variances and waivers are completely wrong. Every setback should be at least 2,000 feet.

Wood Duck has not provided any mitigation plan for public comment and therefore, no one knows what to expect. I am also concerned with the political climate on the federal, state and local level. We do not know if there will be government officials to oversee the project and ensure that the endangered species are protected and that sufficient mitigation efforts are in place. The watershed, KARST topography, subterrain water flow to Green River and Mammoth Cave will be affected. Wood Duck has dismissed every local concern with computer research.

I am adamantly opposed to this **as a property owner with adjacent property.** Please cancel this project and save my farm and the farmer who leases it. Perhaps he should be compensated for the loss of income from the detrimental runoff water which will only increase.

Our property is surrounded by the proposed solar development. It is on the back, across the road and on one side of our home. We knew nothing about this until after it was approved by local planning and already announced as a "done deal." We did not know about any meetings or opportunities to speak.

We are opposed to the variances granted by planning and zoning which put these panels right in our faces. We request a minimum of a 2,000 feet setback from our home and outbuildings.

We have raised our family at this location and were hoping to buy additional land for our children's homes, but this development will ensure that will never happen. They will have to locate outside of the solar project. This development has destroyed families and friendships.

Some of this is prime agricultural land that we are leasing and their decision to "sign on" will destroy our farming land base in Barren County.

Our property is adjacent to a large section of the proposed development in Barren County. The solar development is directly across the road AND on one side of our home.

We are completed opposed to this development and had no knowledge off this development until it was already approved by our local planning and zoning. We attended the information sessions at Cave City and were completely ignored with our concerns and requests. Therefore, we are writing to you with hope that you will listen to our concerns.

First, we are concerned that this is going to be within a few feet of our home on the side. We were not advised that planning had granted variances of 50-20-10-0 feet and we had no input. ZERO.

It is absolutely abhorrent that we will be looking out our front door at a 300-400 acre field of panels and we had no vice in the decision. The glare from this and the light pollution, the runoff water, and the increased heat is not welcomed.

We are concerned with fire potential and it spreading. WE do not have sufficient water lines (most are 4 inch) in the project area to support commercial properties as stipulated in county building codes which require a 6 inch water line for a commercial property. We know the fires can spread quickly and this puts us more at risk being so close to our home. It should be a minimum of 2,000 feet from our home where we are raising our baby boy.

Our baby boy will not have the luxury of fields to explore, birds to observe, deer to chase. He will instead face the detrimental decisions of greedy neighbors who made decisions in spite of friendship and respect for others. And while we understand KY government is encouraging "green energy" our experience in the health industry refutes many of the claims and we will now live with the fear of the unknown and what we do know and the risk this will create for OUR boy.

We are concerned with the analysis Wood Duck submitted about the glare. We disagree with their conclusion that the reflection will only be a few minutes because of the way the sun sets in this area and the rotation of the panels. It will be directly in our front windows, but more importantly, it will be blinding to motorists, Amish buggies, and school buses full of children and all of our neighbors, whom we care about.

We raise show chickens and goats. This project stands to damage our animals should a glass panel break and shatter, leaving glass shards and the dangerous metals on the ground that can quickly be transferred to our property by runoff and rain – both of which will be tremendously impacted by this proposed development. Again, it should be at least a 2,000 feet setback.

We estimate approximately a mile (maybe a mile and ½) of road frontage of the solar panels across the roads. We are aware of Wood Duck's proposal to plant Arborvitaes along the road frontage. We do not approve of this selection as they are not native to Kentucky and are prone to disease and bagworms which are deadly to our show chickens. We want to have a variety of trees, plants and bushes that will offer a pleasing frontage to conceal all of their panels. We want walnut, oak, maple, cherry, dogwoods, tulip trees, poplar trees and a variety of native bushes, flowers and wildflowers to help mitigate the hundreds of acres they are destroying and the habitats they have eliminated.

We are concerned with the decline in our property values. We do not believe the assessments by Kirkland and Wood Duck. They stated that solar panels AFFECT nothing...not houses, farmland, vacant residences. We know this isn't true.

Our mother/mother-in-law is a real estate agent and has assured us that we will lose significant money on our property because of the solar panels. The fact these are commercial solar plants with chainlink fencing creates an industry and commercial look to the area. It will destroy the farmland and reduce all farmer's and all owner's equity and we have had no voice in any of these decisions.

We have one additional outbuilding and would request that it too be included in a 2,000 feet setback.

Commercial solar developments do not belong in residential areas and we ask that you stop this project. We are adamantly opposed to this as a property owner with adjacent property. Please cancel this project and save our farm.

My farm property is adjacent to a large section of the proposed development in Barren County. I lease this land for agriculture; however, I purchased it with the intent of building my retirement oasis in the country where wildlife roams and the Sandhill Crane are abundant.

I was told by neighbors who ARE participants in this project that it wasn't going to be completed. They withheld information and I found out after it was approved. I voiced concerns to Wood Duck, but they failed to address my concerns presenting a condescending attitude.

My concerns include their incorrect assessment of property values. Kirkland Appraisals LLC stated "there is no impact on home values due to abutting or adjoining a solar farm; as well as, no impact to abutting or adjacent vacant residential or agricultural land." I'm not sure where Mr. Kirkland pulled these numbers, but they obviously do not apply to a 27-track scattered site development in residential areas. This area is tax assessed as farmland and residential. It should remain as such. To build a commercial solar plant, and FENCE it, within 10 feet of my property line WILL significantly reduce the value of my property and WILL reduce my quality of life; and ultimately prohibit my goal or retiring to Barren County.

As it stands today, my property has significant run-off water due to the topography of adjoining neighbor's property. This will only get worse.

No one has talked to me about how this will be corrected. There are trees and vegetation which help to some extent, but when this is removed, the run-off will only increase. Solar Panels do not absorb water and if the panel are in a horizontal position when the rains fall, the velocity of the water will increase, landing on soil which has been disturbed and will only increase in

volume and strength as it flows thru the crops on my field, washing away the seeds, nutrients and soil. My income will be severely affected by this ill-conceived plan.

I am also concerned about the community and the disruption to the agricultural community. Solar developments should be placed in areas which do not adversely affect farmland and the farming community.

This development impacts my land and my income.

I do not believe this project was approved correctly. I do not believe it has been handled appropriately. It has been concealed from the community for reasons still unknown. The variances and waivers are completely wrong. Every setback should be at least 2,000 feet.

Wood Duck has not provided any mitigation plan for public comment and therefore, no one knows what to expect. I am also concerned with the political climate on the federal, state and local level. We do not know if there will be government officials to oversee the project and ensure that the endangered species are protected and that sufficient mitigation efforts are in place. The watershed, KARST topography, subterrain water flow to Green River and Mammoth Cave will be affected. Wood Duck has dismissed every local concern with computer research.

I am adamantly opposed to this **as a property owner with adjacent property.** Please cancel this project and save my farm and the farmer who leases it. Perhaps he should be compensated for the loss of income from the detrimental runoff water which will only increase.

Our property is surrounded by the proposed solar development. It is on the back, across the road and on one side of our home. We knew nothing about this until after it was approved by local planning and already announced as a "done deal." We did not know about any meetings or opportunities to speak.

We are opposed to the variances granted by planning and zoning which put these panels right in our faces. We request a minimum of a 2,000 feet setback from our home and outbuildings.

We have raised our family at this location and were hoping to buy additional land for our children's homes, but this development will ensure that will never happen. They will have to locate outside of the solar project. This development has destroyed families and friendships.

We believe the solar panels are unhealthy and will create health risks for us and our family. Everything from cancer to respiratory illness, to increased heat and noise. It isn't something we support and do not wish to have it in our back door. We are concerned with the glare from the panels and believe it will be extremely dangerous on our narrow and unmarked, twisted and curvy, shoulder less roads.

Just the construction of this project will put many people at risk because the roads are narrow, winding, without shoulders and unmarked, no lighting, blind curves and many, many low flooding areas. We recently had flooding all over this area and the roads were blocked.

Additionally, we are confident the solar panels will reduce the value of our land. The study by Kirkland has no bearing on this scattered site project which encircles many homes, probably 30-40.
