Comments:

I write to request that the Commission disallow this project to proceed. I am a resident of Barren County and an Industrial Engineer.

The risk to the community is high given that the project is unlikely to ever generate a profit. This will leave area residents an installation riddled with hazardous materials with no way to ameliorate the resulting damage.

The project was initiated using previous federal support for "green" energy production as its basis. Federal subsidies to solar energy production facilities are going to crater.

On July 4, 2025, President Trump signed into law a sweeping budget reconciliation bill commonly known as the "One Big Beautiful Bill Act" (the Act).

Sections 48E (Technology-Neutral ITC) and 45Y (Technology-Neutral PTC) If a wind or solar facility does not begin construction within one year of the Act's enactment (i.e., by July 4, 2026), then ITCs and PTCs are terminated unless the facility is placed in service on or before December 31, 2027. New "beginning of construction" guidance is expected to be issued pursuant to a recent executive order.

The gist of my message is this - there is no long term economic basis for building this facility. Its construction will harm the community which will then have no recourse to repair the ensuing damage.

Is the Commission prepared to pay for the damage it can prevent?
