Dear Siting Board Commissioners:

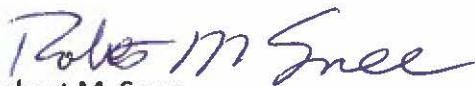
I was one of the people that provided public comment in opposition of approval of the Certificate of Construction in the above referenced matter. During one of the breaks after the public comment section, several of us gathered outside the hearing room and had a conversation with Sebastian (last name unclear in video recording), who was the second person who spoke in favor of approval. He gave his address in Lexington, Kentucky.

During that conversation, Sebastian acknowledged that the reason he was there was because he had received a phone call soliciting his testimony. He did not indicate who the phone call was from.

The only other person who spoke in favor of approval of the Certificate of Construction was Darrell Burks, who gave his address in Lawrenceburg, Kentucky, approximately 115 miles away from the proposed project. What Mr. Burks failed to disclose to the commission, is that he owns approximately 150 acres of land in Barren county and he has entered into a lease with the applicant, allowing the construction of a portion of the project on that property. Furthermore, Mr. Burk's brother and father own an additional 230 acres in Barren County, between them, and they too have entered into leases with the applicant.

The Commission should take these facts into consideration (and their nondisclosure) when assessing the veracity of testimony that was provided by these witnesses.
