This letter is in regard to the fact the governor did not appoint a community representative for the hearing last week in Frankfort.

This seems to be a terrible oversight and one that cannot be corrected. This person was not there to ask any questions and represent the people of Barren County who have been wronged by this company, coming in and keeping their presence a secret while donating to the "important people" who were for sale.

We, the citizens have not been heard and we are asking the Commission to listen to each letter, email and signature and weigh each one heavily.

Also, I am concerned that Geenex has not disclosed the buyer, so all of the questions they answered were their "guess" at that the actual developer will do. The fact they are a shell company with no assets or employees, makes them inexperienced and this is too large of a risk for our area.

As I stated previously, I was not aware of this development until February of this year and would have spoken up if given the opportunity. Solar belongs on large tracks of land, not scattered around places of significance and in residential areas. Agricultural land should be the last choice for solar.
