State the nature of your concern: In reference to Lost City Renewables LLC (Case #2024-00406) In regards to the proposed solar facility planned for Dunmor / Penrod area in south Muhlenberg County (case #2024-00406). I have concerns regarding the installation of a proposed 1300 ac solar facility and the possible negative impacts on the surrounding community. Large scale removal of about 700 acres of forest along with soil removal to level hillsides poses an environmental threat to properties downstream (such as mine) due to silting and soil runoff creating turbidity in waters downstream and possible sedimentation. Likewise, the close proximity to homes and

properties undoubtedly will have a negative effect on neighborhood property values.
