ORDER

On October 22, 2024, Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc. (Columbia) filed a motion requesting to extend the Gas Coast Adjustment Performance Based Rate (PBR) mechanism beyond October 31, 2024, pending a final decision by the Commission in this case. In support of its motion, Columbia Gas stated that allowing the PBR mechanism beyond October 31, 2024, would “maintain the benefits of the mechanism for customers.”


The Commission finds that the request is reasonable and should be granted. Extending the PBR mechanism beyond October 31, 2024, will ensure the status quo until the Commission has made a final determination on the merits.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:
