ORDER

On October 7, 2024, Pike County Solar Project, LLC (Pike County Solar) filed a motion for witnesses Jeannine Johnson, Joshua Crumpler, and Tony Agresti be permitted to participate virtually at the public hearing scheduled for October 16, 2024, at 1 p.m. Eastern Daylight Time in the Richard Raff Hearing Room at the offices of the Public Service Commission at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky. Counsel and witnesses Christina Martens, Erich Miarka, and Justin Ahn will be present at the hearing. Pike County Solar stated that Jeannie Johnson is unable to attend because due to health concerns and Tony Agresti is not available because he has jury duty in New Jersey.¹ Pike County Solar stated that Joshua Crumpler was only being made available as a witness if there were in depth questions regarding project layout, design, and constructability.²

Based upon the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Siting Board finds that Pike County Solar has established good cause to grant the motion to allow witnesses to participate virtually in the October 16, 2024 hearing scheduled in this case subject to certain conditions as set out below. The Siting Board finds that counsel for Pike County Solar and witnesses shall be available for a technology test to ensure there will not be problem with the witnesses' virtual participation on October 14, 2024, at 9 a.m. Siting Board Staff will contact the parties with the necessary login information. The Siting Board also notes that any party unavailable for the technology test must appear for the hearing in person.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Pike County Solar's motion to allow witnesses to participate virtually in the October 16, 2024 hearing is granted.
2. Siting Board Staff shall contact participants with instructions on participating remotely.
3. The remaining witnesses who sponsored testimony or exhibits must be present in person at the hearing.
4. On Monday, October 14, 2024, at 9 a.m. counsel and witnesses for Pike County Solar must be available for technology test with Siting Board Staff to ensure that all required technology is working properly. If a witness is not available at the above time they must appear in person.



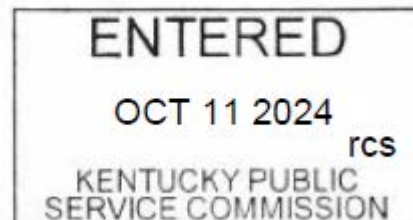
