ORDER

A hearing in the above-styled matter was held on November 6, 2024. At the hearing, the Commission addressed Louisville Gas and Electric Company's (LG&E) motion to deviate from the customer notice requirements filed on November 1, 2024.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, LG&E stated that notice was published in 16 of the scheduled 17 publications areas, but due to publisher error, one area did not get published on schedule.<sup>2</sup> LG&E stated that it has met the purpose of the notice regulation by substantially informing the public through widespread publication efforts.<sup>3</sup> There were no objections noted at the hearing by any party or by Commission Staff.<sup>4</sup> The Commission, from the bench, granted LG&E's motion to deviate from the customer notice requirements set out in 807 KAR 5:001 Section 9(2)(b).<sup>5</sup> At the conclusion of the witness testimony, a procedural schedule was established that provided for post-hearing requests for information and briefing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Post-hearing requests for information, if any, shall be filed on or before November 13, 2024.

2. Responses to post-hearing requests for information shall be filed on or before November 27, 2024.

3. Counsel for LG&E and Louisville/Jefferson County Metropolitan Sewer District (MSD) shall file simultaneous initial briefs in support of their respective post-hearing positions, should they so choose, on or before December 4, 2024.

4. Counsel for LG&E and MSD shall file simultaneous response briefs, should they so choose, on or before December 18, 2024.


5. This case shall stand submitted for a decision by the Commission effective 12:01 a.m. Eastern Standard Time, December 19, 2024.



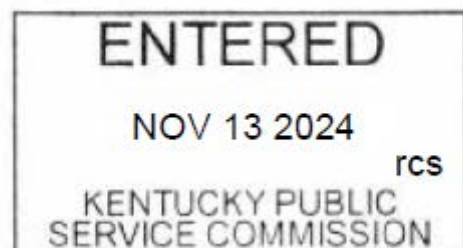
