ORDER

On February 18, 2025, the Commission issued an Order<sup>1</sup> in this matter approving adjustments to water service rates for Ohio County Water District (Ohio District) in its application for a rate adjustment pursuant to 807 KAR 5:076. Appendix B to the Order,<sup>2</sup> Monthly Water Rates, 5/8- x 3/4-Inch Meter, contained typographical errors related to the listed gallon increments.

Appendix B to the February 18, 2025 Order listed the gallon increments under the 5/8- x 3/4-inch Meter section within Monthly Water Rates incorrectly as “First 2,000 gallons; Next 3,000 gallons; Next 5,000 gallons; Next 5,000 gallons; All Over 15,000 gallons”<sup>3</sup> instead of the correct gallon increments that were reflected in Ohio District’s Application as “First 2,000 gallons; Next 18,000 gallons; Next 30,000 Gallons; Next 50,000 Gallons; Over 100,000 Gallons.”<sup>4</sup> The Commission notes the rates calculated were based on the increments derived from Ohio District’s application, and the error is

purely a clerical one. Although the rates calculated per gallon for each gallon increment are correct and are fair, just and reasonable, having the incorrect gallon increments listed in Appendix B to the February 18, 2025 Order could lead to an under recovery by Ohio District because no utility may charge, demand, collect, or receive from any person a greater or less compensation for any service rendered or to be rendered than that prescribed in its filed schedules.<sup>5</sup>

Accordingly, the Commission finds that, with the adjustments to the retail rates, the rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just and reasonable. The effect of this *nunc pro tunc* Order should relate back to the Order of February 18, 2025, in which the Commission approved the methodology, the manner of analysis, and the calculation of the rates. The Commission further finds that any difference between the rates for retail water service placed into effect by Ohio District following the February 18, 2025 Order and the rates implemented in the Appendix to this Order shall be collected over a period of no less than 11 months.

Finding that the February 18, 2025 Order should be amended, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS, *nunc pro tunc*, that:

1. The Monthly Water Rates section of Appendix B to the February 18, 2025 Order is stricken and replaced with the Monthly Water Rates section of the Appendix to this Order.
2. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just and reasonable.
3. All other provisions of the Commission's February 18, 2025 Order that are not in conflict with the terms of this Order shall remain in effect.

4. Within 20 days of the date of service of this Order, Ohio District shall file with the Commission revised tariff sheets containing the approved rates.

5. Ohio District shall collect any undercollection or issue any refund, over a period of no less than 11 months, for any difference between the rates for retail water service placed into effect following the February 18, 2025 Order, and the rates provided in the Appendix to this Order.


6. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Ohio District shall file in this case a statement detailing the amounts billed to its retail customers lesser than the rates authorized in this Order with totals for each type of charge separately stated.
