ORDER

On December 4, 2024, the Commission issued an Order in this matter ordering Cannonsburg Water District (Cannonsburg District) to notify its customers of the implementation of the rates calculated in Commission Staff's Report.<sup>1</sup> The Appendix to the December 4, 2024 Order contained a clerical error, when it used six decimal places for the volumetric charges for the 3/4-Inch x 5/8-Inch Meter and 1-Inch Meter sizes, but used five decimal places in the volumetric charges in the remaining meter sizes.<sup>2</sup>

Finding that the December 4, 2024 Order should be amended, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS, *nunc pro tunc*, that:

1. The Appendix of the December 4, 2024 Order is stricken and is replaced with the Appendix attached to this Order.
2. Within 14 days of the date of service of this Order, Cannonsburg District shall notify its customers of the implementation of the rates calculated in the Commission Staff's Report by publishing notice of the amended rate increase in a newspaper of

general circulation in its territory or placing an insert in bills rendered to its customers. The customer notice shall contain the information set forth in the Appendix to this Order.

3. Cannonsburg District shall provide proof of publication of the notice to the Commission no later than 30 days from the date of this Order.

4. All other provisions of the Commission's December 4, 2024 Order that are not in conflict with the terms of this Order shall remain in effect.

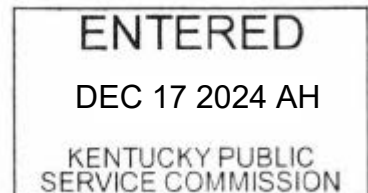

APPENDIX TO AN ORDER OF THE KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE  
COMMISSION IN CASE NO. 2024-00155 DATED DEC 17 2024

On May 22, 2024, the Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC) accepted for filing Cannonsburg Water District’s (Cannonsburg District) application requesting to increase its revenue from water sales by \$397,464, an approximate increase of 15.88 percent. On October 17, 2024, Commission Staff determined Cannonsburg District would require an increase of \$484,805 or 19.37 percent in revenue from water sales. Cannonsburg District requests the PSC approve its recommended revenue requirements and that Cannonsburg District be allowed to implement the revised rates as follows:

The proposed rates shall not become effective until the Public Service Commission has issued an Order approving these rates. The rates will increase the monthly bill of a typical residential customer using 3,382 gallons a month from \$38.51 to \$45.97, an increase of \$7.46, or approximately 19.37 percent.
