<u>O R D E R</u>

On April 4, 2024, Morehead Utility Plant Board (Morehead) filed a tariff to increase its wholesale water rates to Bath County Water District (Bath District) and Rowan Water, Inc. (Rowan Water). Morehead proposed an effective date of July 1, 2024. Subsequent to the April 4, 2024 filing, Morehead filed, on May 17, 2024, revised Water Purchase Agreements (Revised Agreements) with Bath District and Rowan Water. The Revised Agreements contain an effective date of the later of July 1, 2024, or the date the Revised Agreements are deemed to be filed by the Commission.

The proposed rates in the April 4, 2024 filing were based on existing assets only and reflected the removal of Monthly Capital Costs and Meter and Billing Charges, as well as an increase in the volumetric rate of \$0.658 per 1,000 gallons, or 40.5 percent, from \$1.626 per 1,000 gallons to \$2.284 per 1,000 gallons. The effect of the revised rates on the average bill of Bath District and Rowan Water would be an increase of \$7,053.77, or 8.53 percent, and an increase of \$12,370.85, or 10.64 percent, respectively.¹

Morehead responded to four requests for information from Commission Staff. Those responses are attached as Appendix B to this Order and are made a part of the evidentiary record of this case.

The Revised Agreements filed on May 17, 2024, which would supersede a 2000 InterLocal Agreement between Morehead, Bath District, and Rowan Water, set forth another proposed increase to the wholesale rates of \$3.61 per 1,000 gallons effective July 1, 2025, for Rowan Water and July 15, 2025, for Bath District. As support for the proposed 2025 increase, Morehead provided its wholesale rate computation, which was based on existing assets and a new Regional Water Treatment Plant. The Revised Agreements indicate that Morehead will conduct a Cost of Service Study (COSS) based upon actual costs during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025. The Revised Agreements would allow Morehead to recover any difference between the results of the COSS and the \$3.61 per 1,000 gallons rate over a 3-year period, beginning in 2026. Morehead would be permitted to conduct additional cost of service studies for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2026, 2027, or 2028 and if the actual cost to produce water differs from the 2025 COSS, Morehead would allocate the difference over the remainder of the gradual implementation periods beginning June 30, 2026, 2027, or 2028 in the same manner as the initial difference. The Revised Agreements also indicate that Bath District and Rowan Water would receive a credit or reduction equal to their share of capital charges collected from January 2024 to June 2024 for bonds that were paid off in December 2023, and a credit or reduction for their share of the reserve funds pursuant to a 2000 InterLocal Agreement. After July 15, 2028, Morehead would have the right to annually adjust the wholesale rate to reflect changes in its cost of providing water service.

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LEGAL STANDARD

The Commission has exclusive jurisdiction over the rates and service of utilities and is charged with enforcing the provisions of KRS Chapter 278.² A city-owned utility is generally exempt from the Commission's exclusive jurisdiction over utility rates and services.³ However, pursuant to KRS 278.200, the Commission may, under the provisions of KRS Chapter 278:

> [O]riginate, establish, change, promulgate, and enforce any rate or service standard of any utility that has been or may be fixed by any contract, franchise or agreement between the utility and any city, and all rights, privileges, and obligations arising out of any such contract, franchise, or agreement, regulating any such rate or service standard, shall be subject to the jurisdiction and supervision of the commission.⁴

In Simpson County Water District v. City of Franklin, the Kentucky Supreme Court

held that a city providing utility service loses its exemption and "is rendered subject to the

PSC rates and service regulation" pursuant to KRS 278.200 when it enters into a contract

to provide wholesale utility service to a public utility subject to the Commission's

jurisdiction.5

KRS 278.030 provides that a utility may collect fair, just and reasonable rates and

that the service it provides must be adequate, efficient and reasonable. "Whenever any

utility files with the commission any schedule stating new rates, the commission may, upon its own motion . . . , and upon reasonable notice, hold a hearing concerning the reasonableness of the new rates."⁶ Pending the final decision on a proposed schedule or rate, "the commission may, at any time before the schedule becomes effective, suspend the operation of the schedule and defer the use of the rate, charge, classification, or service" for a period up to five months beyond the time when it would otherwise go into effect if a historical test period is used, and up to six month if a forward-looking test period is used.⁷

DISCUSSION

Having reviewed the proposed tariff and Revised Agreements and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the rates to be effective July 1, 2024, filed on April 4, 2024,⁸ are reasonable and should be approved but that an investigation is necessary to determine the reasonableness of the provisions in the Revised Agreements, which were filed on May 17, 2024, regarding future rate revisions to Bath District and Rowan Water and that such investigation cannot be completed by July 1, 2024. Pursuant to KRS 278.190(2), the Commission will, therefore, suspend the effective date of the Revised Agreements for one day until July 2, 2024.

The Commission also finds that, in order to investigate the Revised Agreement, Rowan Water and Bath District should be given the opportunity to participate as a party. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of this Order on Rowan Water and Bath District.

As parties to the Revised Agreements, both water utilities shall have the opportunity to participate in this proceeding, should they so choose.

The Commission directs Morehead to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085⁹ in which the Commission mandated the use of electronic filing procedures listed in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8. Consistent with the filing procedures set forth in Case No. 2020-00085, the Commission finds that electronic filing procedures should be used.

The Commission further finds that a procedural schedule should be established to review the reasonableness of the Revised Agreements. The procedural schedule is attached as Appendix A to this Order.

Additionally, any hearing scheduled in this matter shall be held on the designated day or days and continued until called from the bench by the presiding officer. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 2, if the hearing is not concluded on the designated day, the hearing may be continued upon verbal announcement by the presiding officer. A verbal announcement made by the presiding officer shall be proper notice of the continued hearing. Hearings are held in the Richard Raff Hearing Room at the offices of the Public Service Commission at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky. Witnesses who sponsor schedules, testimony, or responses to requests for information are expected to participate in person at a hearing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. This proceeding is established to investigate the reasonableness of the Revised Agreements.

2. Morehead's proposed Phase 1 rates of \$2.284 per 1,000 gallons are approved for service rendered on and after July 1, 2024.

3. The Revised Agreements, filed on May 17, 2024, are suspended for one day until July 2, 2024, subject to change.

4. Within 20 days of the date of service of this Order, Morehead shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, its revised tariff sheet setting forth the Phase 1 rates approved herein and reflecting their effective date and that they were authorized by this Order.

5. Morehead shall, by counsel, enter an appearance in this proceeding within seven days of the date of service of this Order. The entry of appearance shall include the name, address, telephone number, fax number, and electronic mail address of counsel.

6. Unless otherwise ordered by the Commission, the procedures set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8, related to service and electronic filing of papers shall be followed in this proceeding.

7. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(9), within seven days of the date of service of this Order, Morehead shall file by electronic means a written statement that it waives any right to service of Commission Orders by United States mail and that it or its authorized agent possess the facilities to receive electronic submissions.

8. Unless a party granted leave to intervene states its objection to the use of electronic filing procedures in a motion for intervention, the party shall:

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a. Be deemed to have consented to the use of electronic filing procedures and the service of all papers, including Orders of the Commission, by electronic means; and

b. Within seven days of the date of service of an order of the Commission granting intervention, file with the Commission a written statement that:

(1) It or its authorized agent possesses the facilities to receive electronic transmissions; and

(2) Sets forth the electronic mail address to which all electronic notices and messages related to this proceeding shall be served.

9. If a party objects to the use of electronic filing procedures and the Commission determines that good cause exists to excuse that party from the use of electronic filing procedures, service of documents on that party and by that party shall be made in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(8).

10. The procedural schedule set forth in Appendix A to this Order shall be followed.

11. Morehead shall respond to all requests for information propounded by Commission Staff, whether identified on the procedural schedule or otherwise, as provided in those requests.

12. As set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(11)(a), a person requesting permissive intervention in a Commission proceeding is required to demonstrate either (1) a special interest in the proceeding, which is not adequately represented in the case, or (2) that the person requesting permissive intervention is likely to present issues or develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly

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complicating or disrupting the proceedings. Therefore, any person requesting to intervene in a Commission proceeding must state with specificity the person's special interest that is not otherwise adequately represented, or the issues and facts the person will present that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter. A mere recitation of the quantity of utility service consumed by the movant or a general statement regarding the potential impact of possible modification of rates will not be deemed sufficient to establish a special interest.

13. Any motion to intervene after the date established in the procedural schedule shall also show good cause for being untimely. If the untimely motion is granted, the movant shall accept and abide by the existing procedural schedule.

14. Morehead shall give notice of the hearing in accordance with the provisions set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2). In addition, the notice of the hearing shall include the following statements: "This hearing will be streamed live and may be viewed on the PSC website, psc.ky.gov" and "Public comments may be made at the beginning of the hearing. Those wishing to make oral public comments may do so by following the instructions listed on the PSC website, psc.ky.gov." At the time publication is requested, Morehead shall forward a duplicate of the notice and request to the Commission.

15. At any public hearing in this matter, neither opening statements nor summarization of direct testimonies shall be permitted.

16. Any hearing scheduled in this matter shall be held on the designated day or days and continued until called from the bench by the presiding officer. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 2, if the hearing is not concluded on the designated day, the hearing shall be continued upon verbal announcement by the presiding officer. A verbal

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announcement made by the presiding officer shall be proper notice of the continued hearing.

17. Witnesses who sponsor schedules, testimony, or responses to requests for information shall participate in person at any hearing scheduled in this matter.

18. Pursuant to KRS 278.360 and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(9), a digital video recording shall be made of the hearing.

19. The Commission does not look favorably upon motions for continuance. Accordingly, motions for extensions of times with respect to the schedule herein shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

20. The Commission does not look favorably upon motions to excuse witnesses from testifying at Commission hearings. Accordingly, motions to excuse a witness from testifying at a Commission hearing or from testifying in person at a Commission hearing shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

21. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of this Order upon Bath District and Rowan Water.

ORDINANCE NO 09 :2016

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF MOREHEAD, KENTUCKY CODE OF ORDINANCES, TITLE 5, PUBLIC UTILITIES, CHAPTER 51, GAS AND WATER, SECTIONS 51.01, GAS AND WATER TAP CHARGES AND 51.02 SERVICE RATES AND CHARGES TO INCREASE SAID TAP AND SERVICE FEES

WHEREAS, the City of Morehead Board of City Council established the rates for utilities based upon the recommendation of the Morehead Utility Plant Board;

WHEREAS, the Morehead Utility Plant Board's costs for providing said services to the citizens have increased since the last rate increase was enacted; and

WHEREAS, the Morehead Utility Plant Board has recommended to the Board of City Council that said rates be increased;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of City Council of the City of Morehead, Kentucky that Title 5, Public Utilities, Chapter 51, Gas and Water, Sections 51.1, Gas and Water Tap Charges and 51.02 Service Rates and Charges shall be amended as follows:

51.01 GAS AND WATER TAP CHARGES.

(A) No free use of the services and facilities of the municipal utility system of the city (hereinafter the "system") shall be granted or permitted to any user thereof, including the City of Morehead.

(B) Effective July 1, 2016 [September 1, 2009], the cost for any person, firm, corporation or legal entity desiring to connect or tap onto any water line of the City of Morehead/Morehead Utility Plant Board for residential purposes shall be [five hundred dollars (\$500.00)] eight hundred dollars (\$800.00) each for such water tap.

(C) Effective September 1, 2009, the cost for any person, firm, corporation or legal entity desiring to connect or tap onto any waterline of the City of Morehead/Morehead Utility Plant Board for industrial or commercial purposes shall be the actual cost of labor and material incurred by the Morehead Utility Plant Board.

(D) Effective July 1, 2016 [September 1, 2009], the cost for any person, firm, corporation or legal entity desiring to connect or tap onto any gas line of the City of Morehead/Morehead Utility Plant Board for residential purposes shall be [three hundred dollars (\$300.00)]seven hundred dollars (\$700.00) each for such gas tap.

(E) Effective September 1, 2009, the cost for any person, firm, corporation or legal entity desiring to connect or tap onto any gas line of the City of Morehead/Morehead

Utility Plant Board for industrial or commercial purposes shall be the actual cost of labor and material incurred by the Morehead Utility Plant Board.

(F) Upon payment of the connection or tapping charge the Morehead Utility Plant Board shall cause the connection or tapping to be made.

(G) Any party making any connection without payment of the connection or tapping charge or violating any provision of this section, upon conviction, shall be fined not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and each day's violation shall be deemed a separate offense.

§ 51.02 SERVICE RATES AND CHARGES.

(A) Rates and charges for the use of the water and gas services and facilities of the system shall be based on the consumption of water, and rates and charges for the use of the gas services and facilities of the system shall be based on the consumption of gas. Rates and charges shall be at least adequate to meet the cost of maintaining, repairing, and operating the system, and making required principal and interest payments and deposits to the debt service or depreciation reserve. On that basis, monthly rates and charges are established and fixed, and will be maintained, at not less than the following:

(B) The Utility Plant Board may establish the following maximum rates for natural gas customers within the corporate limits of the city:

Gas Rates

First 1,000 MCF

All purchases over 1,000 MCF

\$3.45 over purchase cost to MUPB from supplier \$1.60 per 1,000 MCF over purchase cost to MUPB from supplier

All charges shall be on a pro rata basis per gas consumption over minimum bill. A minimum bill shall be paid by all customers in an amount to equal the MUPB's actual cost of one thousand (1,000) MCF, from supplier of natural gas plus three dollars and forty-five cents (\$3.45).

(C) Rates and charges for customers of [water and] gas service located outside the corporate limits of the city shall be one hundred twenty percent (120%) of the rate schedule which is to be charged to customers located within the corporate limits of the city.

(D) The industrial charge for gas purchases over 5,000 MCF shall be as follows:

First 5,000 MCF	\$3.45 over purchase cost to MUPB from supplier per first 1,000 MCF and \$1.60 over purchase cost per each additional 1,000 MCF up to 5,000 MCF
Over 5,000 MCF	After first 5,000 MCF, \$1.10 over purchase cost to MUPB per 1,000 MCF
Over 25,000 MCF	After first 25,000 MCF, \$0.93 over purchase cost to MUPB per 1,000 MCF

ORDINANCE SUMMARY ORDINANCE NUMBER 09:2016

An Ordinance of the City of Morehead, Kentucky amending Title 5, Public Utilities, Chapter 51, Gas and Water, Section 51.01, Gas and Water Tap charges and 51.02 Service Rates and charges to increase said fees was given first reading on May 9, 2016 and second reading on June 13, 2016. Said amendment increases the fees as follows:

51.01 GAS AND WATER TAP CHARGES.

(A) No free use of the services and facilities of the municipal utility system of the city (hereinafter the "system") shall be granted or permitted to any user thereof, including the City of Morehead.

(B) Effective July 1, 2016, the cost for any person, firm, corporation or legal entity desiring to connect or tap onto any water line of the City of Morehead/Morehead Utility Plant Board for residential purposes shall be eight hundred dollars (\$800.00) each for such water tap.

(C) Effective September 1, 2009, the cost for any person, firm, corporation or legal entity desiring to connect or tap onto any waterline of the City of Morehead/Morehead Utility Plant Board for industrial or commercial purposes shall be the actual cost of labor and material incurred by the Morehead Utility Plant Board.

(D) Effective July 1, 2016, the cost for any person, firm, corporation or legal entity desiring to connect or tap onto any gas line of the City of Morehead/Morehead Utility Plant Board for residential purposes shall be seven hundred dollars (\$700.00) each for such gas tap.

§ 51.02 SERVICE RATES AND CHARGES.

(A) Rates and charges for the use of the water and gas services and facilities of the system shall be based on the consumption of water, and rates and charges for the use of the gas services and facilities of the system shall be based on the consumption of gas. Rates and charges shall be at least adequate to meet the cost of maintaining, repairing, and operating the system, and making required principal and interest payments and deposits to the debt service or depreciation reserve. On that basis, monthly rates and charges are established and fixed, and will be maintained, at not less than the following:

Please see the below responses to your questions. I am also compiling the retail rates for the past 10 years to provide to support the below answers. I had hoped to have them for you today. However, it is looking like I won't have those put together until sometime Monday.

1. Provide the complete retail calculations that justify a lower increase.

Response: See attached files Water Retail Rate Model Updated with 2023 Audit Results.xlsx Retail Water Rate Study Report FINAL after 2023 Audit.docx

2. Explain why the proposed retail increase is so much less than the proposed wholesale increases.

Response: There are three dynamics occurring that caused the proposed retail increase to be less than the wholesale increase: (a) Morehead UPB has been raising retail rates by a higher percentage over the past few years to prepare for the large debt service that will become payable soon with the water treatment plant currently under construction; (b) Morehead UPB previously computed wholesale water rates according to the methods prescribed in an interlocal agreement dated November 2000 that did not fully include recovery of depreciation; and (c) the interlocal agreement is being replaced by a newly-negotiated water purchase contract that prescribes a costof-service rate study that includes recovery of depreciation. The retail customer rates have been increased as needed over the years to carry any shortfall that may have been created by not fully recovering depreciation from the wholesale customers.

3. State whether any components of the retail rate analysis are excluded from the proposed rate (i.e. depreciation or debt service).

Response: No components that were included in the wholesale cost of service rate study were excluded from the retail rate study. The retail rate study includes the same cost components as the wholesale rate study.

4. Explain if anything changed from the prior cost methodology that would result in a higher percentage increase to the wholesale customers. If the allocations changed, explain the reasoning for the change.

Response: The prior cost methodology was negotiated between Morehead UPB and its two wholesale customers. The methodology had three components (a) a flat meter-based charge; (b) a flat capital recovery charge; and (c) a consumption-based charge. The meter-based charge was minimal (\$10 per meter per month) not cost-based and did not vary from year to year. The capital recovery charge was fixed for the debt service that had been issued when the inter-local agreement was updated, however there was a second component of the capital charge that was based on the depreciation of items that were put in service and paid from operations since there was no related debt service connected to those improvements. This partially factored depreciation into the calculation as some of these assets were replacement items to the original plant debt service in the rate. As a point of reference, the COSS wholesale rate was not materially different than the rate calculation that had been made through the inter-local agreement through the previous year. This fixed capital charge including the "unfunded" depreciation has been adjusted each year. The consumption-based charge was based on the operating costs of all water produced for both wholesale and retail.

The allocation methodology changed for two reasons: (a) Due to the major investment in a new water plant and the complexity of how the inter-local agreement would need to be revised since it was based on a "capacity" charge and other detailed calculations and the fact that due to the fixed portion of the costs, the net wholesale cost of water would vary to the customer based on the volume of water they sold over time, Morehead UPB and the wholesale customers wanted the rates calculated by an independent consultant using a standard cost-of-service methodology and (b) Morehead UPD and the wholesale customers wanted a single all-in consumption-based rate, that would be consistent regardless of the volume of water used in any particular year and would give more stability for budgeting and planning for Morehead UPB and the wholesale customers.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Morehead Utility Plant Board requested that Kentucky Rural Water Association perform a retail water rate study based upon current expenses as well as anticipated additional expenses associated with construction of a new water treatment plant. Following are the key assumptions made when developing the rate model:

- Audited revenues and expenses from the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 would be used as the test year.
- Debt totaling \$52,052,602 will be issued, with \$44,998,000 at 0.50% with repayment over 30 years and \$7,054,602 at 2.75% interest over 20 years.
- Depreciation expense would be included in the revenue requirement, including the new water treatment plant.
- Water rates associated with this rate study would be implemented in two phases:

Phase 1	(based on current expenses)	July 1, 2024
Phase 2	(based on new treatment plant)	To Be Determined

The study is complete and the results are presented in this report. The Schedule of Adjusted Operations (SAO) lists the revenues and expenses and applies certain adjustments. The adjustments to revenues are to recognize the difference between the audited amounts and computed amounts based upon consumption and current rates and to recognize proposed changes in wholesale rates.

The study also shows the computations for Revenue Requirements which recover operating expenses, depreciation expenses, debt service, and debt service coverage. Considering revenues recovered from Wholesale Sales of Water, the total Revenue Required from Retail Sales of Water for Phase 1 comes to \$2,270,346. This is less than the existing pro forma sales of \$2,587,757 and indicates that no rate increase is needed for Phase1. However, the total Revenue Required from Retail Sales of Water for Retail Sales of Water for Phase 2 comes to \$2,882,128. This is more than the existing pro forma sales of \$2,587,757 and indicates that an overall rate increase of 11.38% is needed for Phase2.

Computations from this study are included in the Schedule of Adjusted Operations, Revenue Requirements, Depreciation Expense, and Debt Service Requirements. The current and recommended water rates and a comparison of existing and proposed bills are also included. The computations performed in the study are attached to this Executive Summary.
