ORDER


On July 10, 2024, Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless (Verizon Wireless) and Tower Co 2013, LLC (Tower Co 2013) (together, Joint Applicants) filed a notice of intent to use electronic filing, stating they would file an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct a wireless communications facility no later than November 30, 2024. On January 31, 2025, Joint Applicants filed a request to withdraw the notice of intent to use electronic filing. Based on the request to withdraw the notice and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Joint Applicants established good cause to withdraw its notice, and therefore, this proceeding should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case is dismissed and removed from the Commission's Docket.
