SITING BOARD STAFF'S POST-HEARING REQUEST FOR INFORMATION
TO WOOD DUCK SOLAR LLC

Wood Duck Solar LLC, (Wood Duck Solar), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested is due on October 14, 2025. The Siting Board directs Wood Duck Solar to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085¹ regarding filings with the Commission. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the question to which the response is made and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a

governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Wood Duck Solar shall make timely amendment to any prior response if Wood Duck Solar obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect or incomplete when made or, though correct or complete when made, is now incorrect or incomplete in any material respect.

For any request to which Wood Duck Solar fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Wood Duck Solar shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied and scanned material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, Wood Duck Solar shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. Provide a one-page map with the planned collection system and identify which segments are underground and which segments are above ground.
2. Provide the leases for all participating landowners, for all components.

3. Provide a table with the distances from the nearest non-participating residence (dwelling not property line) to the following:

- a. Fencing.
- b. Closest solar panel.
- c. Closest inverter.
- d. Collection Substation.
- e. Substation.

4. Provide any interconnection studies including the facilities studies that have been received by Wood Duck Solar since the application was initially filed.

5. Explain whether this project will utilize water storage tanks, either during or post-construction as a permanent fixture. If there will be water storage tanks utilized, provide the size, usage duration, and a map identifying the location within the project footprint.

6. Explain the timing of the leases executed for the participating landowners relative to the clearing of areas of vegetation/forest of the project who are located in the vicinity between Millstown Road, Apple Grove Road, Park City-Bon Ayr Road, and the Cumberland Parkway.
