Morgan county water district has multiple employees out in the field and most are sitting at the district office with nothing to do and are getting paid for sitting 4 or 5 were hired after completing a Gateway program
The water waste in this county is horrible with multiple calls about water coming out of the ditches or across roads or under roads from county water lines but nothing is really being done to fix or repair this

A leak on jones creek was reported for the past 3 years and finally it was fixed last fall

If you look at the public audits how much the payroll has increased since 2019 almost to the point of tripled which people can not understand this at all because nothing has changed as far as working on leaks etc to save water

I am speaking on behalf of the citizens that are on a fixed income cannot afford To pay almost double or triple what they are already paying
Please look into this before agreeing to increase the rates
