I purchased the building where I live in 2022, but it has been in my family since it was built in 1918. The city and state forced the closure of the business that had been on the first floor since 1932, in 2016. Since then there has been no commercial enterprise there, nor is there going to be, as long as I own the building, which will be until the day of my death. Despite this, Duke refuses to status the location as a residence, but to make more money wants to call it a business. They have greatly frustrated me and wasted dozens of hours of my time, as I started this procedure

2023, followed their protocols, filling out a rate change form, only to be told weeks later that that does not apply in Kentucky. I got a BPEM number, only to be told months later that the case was and had been closed, but no one informed me of that. Now I am told that to be considered a residence Duke's requirements include having a bathroom, bedroom and kitchen on both floors of my structure. In short, not every house has a bedroom on each floor, some do not have a bathroom on both floors and I doubt most have a kitchen on both floors. There is not and will not be a business in my residence. There is no city, nor county occupational licenses, no Kentucky Secretary of State filing, no tax records and the property taxes are in my name. That should be more than enough to satisfy the fact that there is not a business here, nor is there going to be a business. Moreover, to open a business in this place is further complicated by the fact that this is an historic district, which brings all kinds of restrictions and added requirements, should a business wish to locate here. If they want to draw it up, I am even willing to sign an affidavit to the effect that I will not operate, allow or permit, in any way, a business to operate here. I should not be burdened with this in this way. Duke is being completely unreasonable. Please schedule a hearing where I can have my grievances honestly considered. Thank you.
