BULLOCK PEN DISTRICT'S RESPONSE TO COMMISSION STAFF'S THIRD REQUEST FOR INFORMATION

Comes now Bullock Pen Water District (Bullock Pen District) and submits the following Response to the Commission Staff's Third Request for Information.

- Refer to Bullock Pen District's response to Commission Staff's Second
 Request for Information, Item 2 and Bullock Pen District's Answer.
- a. Explain, including all inputs, how Bullock Pen District calculated the bulk rate adjustment that would lower Mr. Gaines' bill to \$1,756.40. Include in this calculation the average monthly bill for Mr. Gaines calculated as an average of the twelve- month period preceding the leak, and Bullock Pen District's wholesale water rate nearest to Mr. Gaines' residence.
- b. Explain whether Bullock Pen District offered this adjustment for multiple months or only one month.

Response:

(a) The district used Mr. Gaines' 12-month average of 4,000 gallons and including utility tax, totaled \$52.51 for the month.

The remaining 474,000 gallons were charged at the City of Williamstown's bulk rate, a rate of \$3.49 per thousand gallons. The total cost of the remaining 474,00 gallons, including utility tax, equals \$1,703.89.

- (b). The bulk rate adjustment was only offered for 1 month. There were no other months in which the usage was greater than 200% additional usage.
- 2. Provide all written communication between Bullock Pen District and Mr. Gaines.



Once again, I'm not purposefully putting you guys off and making you wait for a response from me, this weather is absolutely killing me and I'm just stretched thin.

Amy, from our office, said that she talked to Belden on the phone today but here is what happened:

When we repaired the leak in your yard, I reinstalled the meter and I simply installed it backwards. What this resulted in is when meters were read this month the reading totaled up to a negative water usage for the month, which is obviously impossible. I personally went out and figured out it was in backwards and just turned the meter around to the correct position.

You don't have an issue on your side at all, the water that was in the crock was just ground water and snow that had fallen in and melted.

We noticed that there were tracks to and from in the snow the meter. Not sure why anyone was there physically at the meter. Was there an issue reading the reading or a high usage issue to flag someone to come out to check the meter?

So we thought we should check the meter today to make sure there wasn't an issue. The crock is completely full of water so we are not sure if there is a leak on your side or ours or if it is snow melt but can't see the meter to make sure it isn't running.

We also noticed that the top section of the crock is broken from when the work was done previously.

We need to have someone come out to check why the crock is full of water especially given the previous issues.

We wanted to report it right away so that it could be addressed as soon as possible.

Please let me know when we can expect to see someone out to check the meter.

When we arrived back to our office, one of the maintenance guys said he thought he may have ran over one of the cinder blocks out by the driveway, but wasn't sure. If you see one of the blocks damaged or needs moved or rearranged, please just let me know. Also, generally we wait until spring time to re-seed and straw the yard back, when we have a repair in winter months, if that sounds sufficient then expect us in spring, we will level the area back down to "grade", then seed and straw the area. - >> We called you this morning 12/1/24 at 7:00 twice from to report that there is a leak on your side of the water meter that is filling up our meter base.
- >> The emergency tech called us back and we requested an email address to send information in writing.
- >> Paul Harp called us back at 7:39 and gave us his email address.

 Requests for communication in writing was expressed to him at that time.
- >> Our water is turned off and it is still leaking into the meter base / crock (where the meter is and has to be the main as our water is turned off at the meter and it is still filling up).
- >> Before someone comes out to inspect it we must be notified by phone (the number above) and in writing as well as someone verifies someone is home when they arrive and are here when the work is performed. We will be home today, but still must be verified.
- >> This is a working number and is on.
- >> No one is to be on our property without us being there.
- >> No equipment is to be on the property until you have hand dug to find the problem.
- >> No work is to be done without us being there.
- >> There will be minimal disturbance to our property. Meter should be accessed from the road.
- >> Before work starts, someone needs to come to the house and let us know. If no one answers, they need to call us at
- >> All communication needs to be in writing, including before work starts, during repairs and coordinating fixing any and all damage done to the yard by the repairs.
- >> You are to work from the road, not from our driveway or parking lot. It is a nasty muddy mess due to the weather. The use of our drive and parking lot is prohibited.
