ORDER

On December 10, 2024, Shelby Energy Cooperative, Inc. (Shelby Energy) filed its application<sup>1</sup> for an increase of rates based on a historical test year pursuant to KRS 278.180 and KRS 278.190.<sup>2</sup> Shelby Energy proposed an effective date of January 1, 2025, for its revised rates and tariff schedules.<sup>3</sup> On January 6, 2025, the Commission suspended the effective date of the proposed rates for five months, up to and including June 9, 2025, and established a procedural schedule.<sup>4</sup>

On June 24, 2025, Shelby Energy filed notice, pursuant to KRS 287.190(2), that it intended to place rates proposed in its application into effect, subject to refund, effective July 1, 2025.<sup>5</sup> Shelby Energy stated that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, Shelby Energy will

maintain its records in a manner to permit refunds, should a subsequent Commission order necessitate such a refund.<sup>6</sup>

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, pursuant to 278.190(2), Shelby Energy shall maintain its records in such a manner as will allow Shelby Energy, the Commission, or any customer to determine the amounts to be refunded, and to whom, in the event a refund is ordered upon final resolution of this matter.

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
