ORDER

On December 23, 2024, Complainant John Russell tendered a formal complaint with the Commission against Grayson Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (Grayson RECC).

Pursuant to Commission regulation in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 20(1), a complaint is required, amongst other items, to state

- (c). Fully, clearly, and with reasonable certainty, the act or omission, of which complaint is made, with a reference, if practicable, to the law, order, or administrative regulation, of which a failure to comply is alleged, and other matters, or facts, if any, as necessary to acquaint the commission fully with the details of the alleged failure; and
- (d). The relief sought.

Pursuant to Commission regulation in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 20(4)(a), upon receipt of a formal complaint, the Commission must determine whether the complaint establishes a *prima facie* case. A complaint establishes a *prima facie* case when, on its face, it states sufficient allegations that, if uncontradicted by other evidence, would entitle

the complainant to the requested relief. If a complaint fails to establish a *prima facie* case, it may be dismissed. It is the Complainant's responsibility to file information in their complaint that says what the issue is, the relief they are requesting, the basis for the claimed relief, and any documentation to supplement the complaint.


Based upon a review of the tendered complaint, the Commission is unable find that it establishes a *prima facie* case, but does provide the Complainant an opportunity to amend the complaint to establish a *prima facie* case. Here, the Commission finds that additional information is needed for the complaint to establish a *prima facie* case. The amended complaint must sufficiently state what the issue is, the relief Complainant is requesting, and the basis for the claimed relief. If the Complainant cannot amend the complaint sufficiently within twenty days of service of this order to establish a *prima facie* case, then the complaint will be dismissed.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. The Complainant, John Elwood Russell, amend his complaint in order to establish a *prima facie* case within twenty days of service of this order.
