The recent announcement of another 13.6% hike on top of previous increases — places an unbearable burden on households across our community. Many of us live in areas where KU is the only provider available, leaving us with no choice but to accept these rising costs. Unlike member-owned cooperatives such as Kenergy, KU operates as a for-profit entity, and its repeated rate hikes feel more like profit-driven gouging than necessary infrastructure investment. This isn't just affecting those considered poor or needy - it's working-class families and middleincome earners, many of whom are living paycheck to paycheck and already stretched thin by inflation, housing costs, and medical expenses. I urge the Commission to consider the following: • Reject or reduce the proposed rate increase, especially for residential customers. • Explore pathways for utility choice in underserved areas, allowing consumers to opt into cooperative models where feasible. • Mandate transparency and accountability from KU regarding how ratepayer funds are used. • Expand energy efficiency programs and billing assistance for struggling households not just the lowest income bracket. As you consider this decision, I encourage you to reflect on Proverbs 31:8-9: "Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves, for the rights of all who are destitute. Speak up and judge fairly; defend the rights of the poor and needy." This verse reminds us that leadership must stand for justice — not only for those on the margins, but for all who carry silent burdens.
