A proposal to establish a third rate increase in just four short years, I would ask that you consider average income increases for Kentucky families yearly salaries are a minimal percentage of their wages. Please deny this proposal.
The percentage of increase seems like a small number. While we do absolutely need and appreciate the essential service provided by Kentucky Utilities, Kentucky families are struggling to make ends meet with increases in cost of daily living across the board, please do not allow increase after increase that allowing KU to keep charging whatever they want, just because we need their service.
Our family as an example, received a 3% merit based salary increase this year. KU is going crazy with their increase percentages by comparison!
This proposed rate increase will add an additional burden by increasing disconnect fees for families that are already trying to band-aid together an honest living, but genuinely struggling to just find extra dollars beyond the increases that are already

being reflected in our power bills.
