State the nature of your concern: LG&E is trying to punish solar customers. We agreed to net metering of NMS-2 % of dollar credit for what flows back into the grid. Existing customers with this setup should NOT be changed for the worse. We have been getting 69.5% credit for what we supply back to the grid and have to pay connection fees and others. The original NMS-1 deal gave kW for kW put back into the grid. LG&E is trying to lower the % credit given back to customers that have an existing agreement. They are stealing from us and asking the government for permission. You should not approve this measure and instead bolster up the protections for solar customers by forcing them to increase our credits given for the solar we produce.
