Not only am I worried about the solar panels themselves, but the resulting run-off from those panels. Greasy Creek lies in a flood plane. It already floods up onto the roadway and any additional run-off from the solar field will make it much worse.

I am also concerned for my child who has special needs due to autism. He has difficulty adjusting to changes in routine, and other items such as noise. If this is too close to us, I am afraid the construction phase will be an extremely difficult thing for him.

My main concern is how close to my house they are planning to put the panels. I do not want this right up on my house. I am concerned about how the company plans to block this from my property. I am going to need more than just a few evergreen trees blocking it. In another project, the trees they planted did not survive the heat from the panels and have almost all died. I do not believe that will work in this case either.
