This is to address the Exie Solar, LLC Responses to Siting Board Staff's First Request for Information. Their Response to Request No. 60 relates to us. We are the closest residence to the proposed substation. It is supposed to be diagonally across the road from our house.

Noura Hennen did come to our house, but she came with one of the participating landowners. This made having any real conversation about our concerns basically impossible. The information she later sent to us had nothing to do with the substation, switchyard or the battery storage. What she sent was some sheets from First Solar talking about reviews of solar panels. This didn't really provide any useful information for our situation.

Since Noura Hennen was not able to address our main concerns, they are still unanswered. Those concerns are attached. One thing that she did state was that as far as the sinkholes are concerned, they would just fill those in and build on top of them. Anybody who knows anything about sinkholes would know this is not a good idea.
