Comments:

I strongly oppose the proposed water rate increase. For years, the service provided by this company has been inadequate. Water frequently runs out, pressure is terrible, and overall service is unacceptable. The management, including Mr. Pyles, demonstrates a clear lack of concern for the people of Meade County—especially considering he doesn't even reside in our district.

The quality of water has caused substantial personal financial burden. Due to excessive calcium buildup, I have spent over \$15,000 in the last 18 years replacing appliances alone. Asking the residents of Meade County to pay more for water under these conditions is unreasonable. Many in this community simply cannot afford higher rates, particularly when the service we receive does not meet basic standards.

I urge the board to reject this proposed rate hike and prioritize fixing the ongoing issues before considering any increase in charges.
