COMMISSION STAFF'S FIRST REQUEST FOR INFORMATION  
TO TERRI MAXINE HURLEY

Terri Maxine Hurley, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission the following information by either mailing the response to the Public Service Commission at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602, or by emailing the response to PSCED@ky.gov. The information requested is due on June 10, 2026

Ms. Hurley shall make timely amendment to any prior response if Ms. Hurley obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect or incomplete when made or, though correct or complete when made, is now incorrect or incomplete in any material respect.

For any request to which Ms. Hurley fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Ms. Hurley shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied and scanned material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding

in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When filing a paper containing personal information, Ms. Hurley shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

A copy of this request should be served on Terri Maxine Hurley by U.S. Postal Service First-Class mail and Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested at 1834 Rockhouse Rd., Phelps, KY 41553.

a. Confirm if this is the only structure located at 1834 Rockhouse Rd., Phelps, KY 41553 (service address) that is being supplied with electricity. If unable to confirm, explain.

b. Identify any other equipment, structures or other sources of electrical consumption at the service address, including but not limited to detached structures, exterior lighting, farm or commercial equipment, or any other connected electrical load.
