ORDER

On August 1, 2025, East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (EKPC) filed its application for a general adjustment of rates pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 16, as well as modifications to several of its existing tariffs, amortization of certain regulatory assets and relief from certain ongoing reporting and filing obligations. The application proposed that the new rates become effective on September 1, 2025.

Pursuant to KRS 278.180(1), changes to any rate by any utility is prohibited except upon 30 days' notice to the Commission. Therefore, since the application was accepted for filing as of August 1, 2025, the earliest date that EKPC's proposed rates can be effective is September 1, 2025. Having reviewed EKPC's application, the Commission finds that an investigation is necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed rates, and that an investigation cannot be completed by September 1, 2025. Therefore, pursuant to KRS 278.190(2), the Commission will suspend the effective date of the proposed rates for five months, up to and including January 31, 2026.

The Commission further finds that a procedural schedule is necessary to review the reasonableness of the proposed rates. Therefore, the Commission establishes the procedural schedule attached as an Appendix to this Order.

In addition, the Commission, on its own motion, hereby schedules an informal technical conference (ITC) on August 26, 2025, at 10 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time, to take place in-person at the Commission's offices at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky, to allow EKPC to present on the following topics: (1) revenue requirement and related revenue adjustments; (2) allocation; (3) regulatory assets; (4) tariff changes related to RTEP expense; and (4) allocation in the corresponding sixteen owner-member cooperative cases. Persons not actively presenting or participating may attend virtually. Commission Staff will coordinate with the parties to provide a link for participation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. EKPC's proposed rates are suspended for five months, up to and including January 31, 2026.
- 2. The procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix to this Order shall be followed.
- 3. An ITC shall be held on August 26, 2025, at 10 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time, to take place in person at the Commission's offices at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky.
- 4. Commission Staff shall provide a link to parties for virtual participation, if necessary.

- 5. EKPC shall respond to all requests for information propounded by Commission Staff, whether identified on the procedural schedule or otherwise, as provided in those requests.
- 6. Any party filing a paper with the Commission shall file an electronic copy in accordance with the electronic filing procedures set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked. The Commission directs the parties to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085¹ regarding filings with the Commission.
- 7. As set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(11)(a), a person requesting permissive intervention in a Commission proceeding is required to demonstrate either (1) a special interest in the proceeding that is not adequately represented in the case, or (2) that the person requesting permissive intervention is likely to present issues or develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings. Therefore, any person requesting to intervene in a Commission proceeding must state with specificity the person's special interest that is not otherwise adequately represented, or the issues and facts that the person will present that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter. A mere recitation of the quantity of utility service consumed by the movant or a general statement

regarding a potential impact of possible modification of rates will not be deemed sufficient to establish a special interest.

- 8. Any motion to intervene filed after the date established in the procedural schedule shall also show good cause for being untimely. If the untimely motion is granted, the movant shall accept and abide by the existing procedural schedule.
- 9. Witnesses who sponsor schedules, testimony, or responses to requests for information shall participate in person at any hearing scheduled in this matter.
- 10. All parties shall file a witness list at least seven days prior to the hearing date.
- 11. Pursuant to KRS 278.360 and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(9), a digital video recording shall be made of the hearing.
- 12. The Commission does not look favorably upon motions for continuance. Accordingly, motions for extensions of time with respect to the schedule herein shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.
- 13. The Commission does not look favorably upon motions to substitute witnesses or excuse witnesses from testifying at Commission hearings. Accordingly, motions to substitute witnesses or excuse a witness from testifying at a Commission hearing or from testifying in person at a Commission hearing shall be made in writing at least 14 days prior to the hearing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.
