ORDER

On July 30, 2025, Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke Energy Ohio) submitted a \$18,078.00 application fee, as required by KRS 278.706(5) and 807 KAR 5:100 Section 5. The fee was acknowledged by letter from the Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting (Siting Board) dated July 30, 2025. As of April 2, 2026, the Siting Board had accrued \$24,492.15 in case-related expenses, for a shortfall of \$6,414.15, as of that date. On April 27, 2026, an Order was issued to Duke Energy Ohio to pay the supplemental fee of \$6,414.15¹ On May 13, 2026, the fee was acknowledged by a letter from the Siting Board.²

Since June 12, 2026, the consulting fee has been reconciled and finalized; therefore, creating a short fall of \$10,545.00 in case-related expenses. KRS 278.706(5) provides, “[i]f a majority of the members of the board find that an applicant's initial fees are insufficient to pay the board's expenses associated with the application, including the

board's expenses associated with legal review thereof, the board shall assess a supplemental application fee to cover the additional expenses.”

The Siting Board, therefore, finds that Duke Energy Ohio should pay an additional amount totaling \$10,545.00 as a supplemental application fee for expenses already incurred.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Duke Energy Ohio is assessed a supplemental application fee of \$10,545.00.
2. Duke Energy Ohio shall remit payment to the Siting Board within 10 days of the date of service of this Order.
3. The payment shall be a certified check or money order made payable to the Kentucky State Treasurer that is delivered or postmarked as mailed to the Office of General Counsel, Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky 40601-8294, before the deadline.






