ORDER

This matter arises from Kentucky Power Company's (Kentucky Power) motion filed on October 9, 2025, requesting an extension of time to submit its responses to certain requests included in Commission Staff's Second Request for Information (Staff's Second Request) and the joint Request for Information of Office of the Attorney General (Attorney General) and Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. (KIUC).¹ Pursuant to the procedural schedule issued by Order on September 11, 2025,² Kentucky Power's responses to these requests were due on October 9, 2025.³

Kentucky Power stated that it received numerous requests for information from Commission Staff, the Attorney General and KIUC on September 24, 2025 and September 29, 2025, respectively.⁴ Kentucky Power explained that due to the number of

requests received from all parties, it needs further time to gather data sufficient to respond to the following requests: Staff's Second Request for Information, Items 29(b), 86, 87, 88, and 93(c) and the Attorney General and KIUC's First Request for Information, Items 6 and 7.⁵ Kentucky Power stated that all other responses to data request that Kentucky Power is not requesting an extension will be filed timely.⁶

Kentucky Power requested an extension of six business days until October 17, 2025, provide responses to the aforementioned requests. Kentucky Power argued that the number of data requests require a significant amount of data to be identified, analyzed and time to adequately review the requested documents to redact any information that is not suitable for public filing.⁷ Kentucky Power stated that despite its diligence and best efforts to prepare complete responses to each of the requests, Kentucky Power requires additional time to produce responses and documents, but will file the remaining information as soon as is practicable and before the requested time, if possible.⁸

Having considered the motion, the Commission finds that the Kentucky Power's request for a six-business day extension to file responses to certain requests for information issued by Commission Staff on September 24, 2025, and certain Requests for Information issued by the Attorney General and KIUC on September 29, 2025, should be granted for good cause shown.
