O R D E R

On December 29, 2025, The Towers, LLC D/B/A Vertical Bridge, and Kentucky RSA 1 Partnership by Cellco Partnership D/B/A Verizon Wireless (Joint Applicants), filed a motion requesting that the Commission stay the proceeding for 60 days to facilitate a settlement with Movant for Intervention, Jennifer Fisk.<sup>1</sup>

According to the motion, Joint Applicants and Ms. Fisk have verbally and preliminarily agreed that Joint Applicants will amend the pending application in the proceeding to reduce the proposed cellular antenna tower height to no more than 195 feet, with a 4-foot lightning rod above such height, and for the tower not to be lighted except as may be required by regulation of the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) or Kentucky Airport Zoning Commission (KAZC).<sup>2</sup> In addition, the tower height is not to be

extended further in the future.<sup>3</sup> In connection with such height limitation and commitment to the absence of lighting, Ms. Fisk is to agree to irrevocably withdraw her pending motion to intervene and release any claims against Joint Applicants with such release running with the chain of title of her property in the vicinity of the proposed cellular antenna tower.<sup>4</sup>

Having considered the Motion, the Commission finds that Joint Applicants have demonstrated good cause to grant a stay in this proceeding and should grant the motion. The Commission encourages the parties to work together for an agreeable resolution in this matter. The Commission will require a filing from the Joint Applicants no more than 75 days after issuance of this Order updating the Commission on the status of the negotiations. In addition, the Commission will issue a new schedule and decision on the motion to intervene filed by Ms. Fisk after that filing, if necessary.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Joint Applicants' On December 29, 2025 Motion for a stay in this proceeding is granted.
2. Joint Applicants shall file an update no more than 75 days after issuance of this Order on the negotiations.
3. Nothing in this Order shall be construed as preventing additional Orders of the Commission.
