ORDER

On September 19, 2025, Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District (Jessamine-South Elkhorn District) tendered an application for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure set forth in KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068.¹ On September 23, 2025, the Commission notified Jessamine-South District that its application was rejected for certain filing deficiencies. On October 3, 2025, Jessamine-South District submitted further documentation to correct the filing deficiencies, and the application was deemed filed as of October 3, 2025.

LEGAL STANDARD

In accordance with KRS 278.015, when a wholesale supplier selling water to a water district increases its rates, the water district has the authority to increase its rate commensurate with the wholesale supplier. The water district must file, within the statutory and regulatory deadlines, a copy of the notice from the wholesale supplier

showing the increase in the wholesale rate, and a statement of the volume of purchased water used to calculate the rate adjustment. The Commission shall approve the filing by order after the above documents are filed.

DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS

Jessamine-South Elkhorn District purchases water from city of Nicholasville (Nicholasville), Kentucky-American Water (Kentucky-American), and the city of Wilmore (Wilmore). Nicholasville notified Jessamine-South Elkhorn District that its wholesale rate would increase from \$3.09 per 1,000 gallons to \$3.55 per 1,000 gallons, effective September 1, 2025.² Jessamine-South Elkhorn District proposes to increase the water rates to its customers effective September 1, 2025, to reflect the increased cost of purchased water from Nicholasville. No changes were proposed for the water rates charged by Kentucky-American and Wilmore.

<u>Unaccounted-for Water Loss</u>

Commission regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 6(3), states that for ratemaking purposes a utility's unaccounted-for water loss shall not exceed 15 percent of the total water produced and purchased, excluding water consumed by a utility in its own operations. In its 2022 Annual Report filed with the Commission, Jessamine-South Elkhorn District reported a water loss of 10.8341 percent.³ In its 2023 Annual Report filed with the Commission, Jessamine-South Elkhorn District reported a water loss of

14.5634 percent.⁴ In its 2024 Annual Report filed with the Commission, Jessamine-South Elkhorn District reported a water loss of 10.2701 percent.⁵ Jessamine-South Elkhorn District's three-year water loss average is 11.8892 percent.⁶ The approximate annual cost of Jessamine-South Elkhorn District's water loss, based on a three-year average, is 143,316.74.⁷ The Commission commends Jessamine-South Elkhorn District for keeping water loss below 15 percent and encourages it to continue to pursue actions to reduce its unaccounted-for water loss.

Financial Condition and Rates

Based on a review of Commission records, Jessamine-South Elkhorn District has not sought a base rate adjustment since Case No. 2022-00050.⁸ In that case, the Commission authorized an increase in Jessamine-South Elkhorn District's rates of \$214,944 or 8.56 percent.⁹ All other rate adjustment cases since Case No. 2022-00050 were a result of purchased water adjustments or treated sewage adjustments.

As documented in annual and audit reports filed with the Commission, Jessamine South Elkhorn District's financial snapshot for 2020 through 2024 is presented below. Rate based income (adjusted net income minus principal payments) was negative from

2020 through 2022 but was positive in 2023 and 2024 due to the rate increase from Jessamine-South Elkhorn District's last rate adjustment case. Cash basis income (rate-based income plus depreciation) was positive in all years.

The Commission finds that Jessamine-South Elkhorn District should monitor its operating performance annually and file future rate cases no less than every three to five years, depending on financial performance, to ensure that its revenue is sufficient to support adequate and reliable service.

Purchased Water Adjustment Factor

In its application, Jessamine-South Elkhorn District proposed a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.50 per 1,000 gallons. During the 12 months ended July 31, 2025, Jessamine-South Elkhorn District purchased 310,241,390 gallons of water from

Nicholasville, 20,981,151 gallons of water from Kentucky-American, 16,848 gallons of water from Wilmore, and sold 289,816,054 gallons of water to its customers. The increase in the cost of purchased water from Nicholasville is \$142,711.03,¹⁰ resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.50 per 1,000 gallons.

The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.50 per 1,000 gallons, as calculated in Appendix A and the rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are fair, just and reasonable and should be approved for water service rendered by Jessamine-South Elkhorn District on and after September 1, 2025, because the rates are supported by evidence of the increase in rates from Jessamine-South Elkhorn District's wholesale water supplier and the volume of purchased water used to calculate the rates in accordance with KRS 278.015.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.50 per 1,000 gallons is approved.
 - 2. The rates proposed by Jessamine-South Elkhorn District are approved.
- 3. The rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are approved for water service rendered by Jessamine-South Elkhorn District on and after September 1, 2025.
- 4. Within 20 days of the date of service of this Order, Jessamine-South Elkhorn District shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
 - This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
