ORDER

On December 31, 2025, Louisville Gas and Electric Company (LG&E) filed a petition, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13, and KRS 61.878, requesting that the Commission grant confidential treatment for an indefinite period for the following information contained in LG&E's Quarterly Gas Supply Clause filing:

1. Exhibit B-1, which contains information from which the actual price being paid by LG&E for natural gas to its suppliers can be determined;
2. Exhibit B-2, which contain invoices and monthly usage reports for each month of the reporting period; and
3. Documentation of purchases of sustainable natural gas from a renewable source during the reporting period identifying the supplier, cost, and amount.

As a basis for its petition, LG&E asserted that public disclosure of this information would adversely impact LG&E's ability to negotiate future gas supply contracts at favorable prices, and therefore would impair LG&E's ability to minimize the price of natural gas paid by LG&E's customers. For this reason, LG&E argued that public disclosure is prohibited under KRS. 61.878(1)(c)(1), which prohibits public disclosure of records that

are confidential or proprietary that, if publicly disclosed, would result in competitive advantage to the discloser's competitors.

Having considered the petition and the material at issue, the Commission finds that LG&E's petition should be granted. LG&E's competitors could use the designated material to compete with LG&E for these supplier's business or suppliers could use the data to unfairly negotiate with LG&E. The material at issue is also generally recognized as confidential or proprietary. Thus, it meets the criteria for confidential treatment and is exempted from public disclosure pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13, and KRS 61.878(1)(c)(1).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. LG&E's December 31, 2025 petition for confidential treatment is granted.
2. The designated material granted confidential treatment by this Order shall not be placed in the public record or made available for public inspection for an indefinite period or until further order of this Commission.
3. Use of the designated material granted confidential treatment by this Order in any Commission proceeding shall comply with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13(9).
4. If the designated material granted confidential treatment by this Order becomes publicly available or no longer qualifies for confidential treatment, LG&E shall inform the Commission and file with the Commission an unredacted copy of the designated material.
5. If a nonparty to this proceeding requests to inspect the material granted confidential treatment by this Order and the period during which the material has been granted confidential treatment has not expired, LG&E shall have 20 days from receipt of

written notice of the request to demonstrate that the material still falls within the exclusions from disclosure requirements established in KRS 61.878. If LG&E is unable to make such demonstration, the requested material shall be made available for inspection. Otherwise, the Commission shall deny the request for inspection.

6. The Commission shall not make the requested material available for inspection for 30 days from the date of service of an Order finding that the material no longer qualifies for confidential treatment in order to allow LG&E to seek a remedy afforded by law.

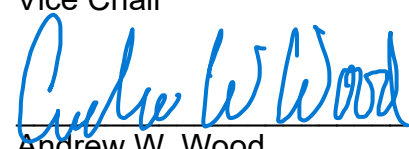

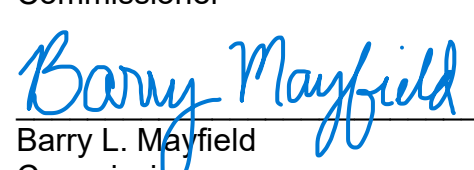
