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To Whom it may concern.

I am writing to request intervention in PSC's proceedings on the proposed application to construct a telecommunication tower on the Fairdealing West site Docket # 2025-00028.

In May of this year, it will be 20 years since we purchased our 53 acres retirement home here at 1083 Capp Springs Rd. Not a typical move from Ohio to our new place in Western Kentucky due to also moving our business, J and J Art. My husband, John Toras, would drive 6 hours one way then load the box truck and then drive back to our new home. This took a year and a total of 25 trips. My health did not allow me to help as much as I wanted to.

I absolutely loved that we moved to Western Kentucky. This house provided us with separate floors. I have my own kitchen to avoid cross contamination. Also, my stained glass shop is on my floor.

Over the years we have done major remodeling - taken down and installed new walls; ^{just one of} in my husband's artistic contribution is a stainless steel spiral staircase; I learned how to and then, just me, installed tile on two new bathroom floors and around my ^{new} Jacuzzi; walled in my back deck and made an exercise room; Thanks to my husband, my kitchen counter is stainless steel; and I assembled the kitchen cabinets and everything else from IKEA, that is the major things just on my floor. Also I can paint, install drywall and mud it, use a saw to cut and then install decorative boards for focal walls,

and also cut and lay flooring. I'm not bragging, I'm just letting you know due to low funds, I and my husband have invested our time, energy and artistic knowledge into our forever home. Now our home has a great floor plan. It has been a labor of love and continues with a few projects left to do — another three focal walls, ^{more} stained glass window panels, and more flooring to cut and lay.

So everything was going as well as expected until I heard the news of the proposed erection of a cell tower in our country neighborhood. Now I am upset, mad and anxious about this devastating news.

First of all — WHY?

My Verizon cell phone has been operating efficiently. Even during

Ice Storm 09 we were the only ones with cell reception. So I am baffled why Capp Springs Rd needs a cell tower. Also, at night I place my cell phone on airplane mode to avoid radiation.

Secondly, and the most important, is the potential health risks.

Currently, I have [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] and just found out

[REDACTED] Right now this is what I'm dealing with and I do not want any radiation from a cell tower in our neighborhood.

Also there are no chemicals used on our property - inside and outside. There is a standing order with Western Kentucky Electric Co. no spraying and no placing chemicals on little trees under their wires

on our property due to potential life threatening Anaphylactic Shock. Yes, chemicals will cause this reaction in me. So for this order to stay in place, I clear the areas under the electric wires. I'm not trying to bore you with my health issues but just trying to explain that I am a highly sensitive person and do not want to be exposed to any extra levels of radiation from a cell tower. I can't even take any Rx or OTC medication due to allergic reactions! I am not concerned just for me and my husband but also concerned for our neighbors and their children and pets. And believe me, as a petite woman, things affect smaller people and animals first. That is a fact! You do know about the little canary in a coal mine — that canary is me!

I've been doing research and look at what I have discovered;

(Radio Frequency)

* Symptoms of RF exposure:

- nausea and vomiting
- diarrhea
- headache
- fever
- hair loss
- dizziness and disorientation
- weakness and fatigue
- bloody vomit and stools from internal bleeding

Do I want any of these?

NO

* Effects from RF documented in scientific research include:

- increase cancer risk
- cellular stress
- memory deficits
- headaches
- reproductive issues
- sleep issues
- impact to the nervous system
- genetic damage

I assume you know that radiation from a cell tower accumulates in the lower lying areas. Guess what? That is us! Our house is halfway down the hill and in the valley

is my organic container (yes, I built them) garden and my husband's shop. I do not want more health issues to deal with!
NO to the TOWER!

Lastly, who is going to pay for the additional cost if the tower is erected:

* cost due to future symptoms and/or illness

* mowing - I will no longer be able to be outside (due to radiation) for 3½ hours mowing our property weekly for the mowing season, the going rate is \$1 per minute so that is 210 minutes x 1 = \$210 weekly to hire someone

* metal siding - Thank goodness I wanted a metal roof when we had to replace the roof! I have not inquired about the cost of metal siding. I will let you know when I get the estimate.

* Increased grocery cost for organic & veggies - no longer have a garden due to the radiation - no bees - no more eating organic veggies from my garden.

* RF/EMF Blocking drapes - Amazon has these on-line. On my floor, I have 15 windows, I will let you know when I get this estimate, too.

* Spectral Frequency Analyzer - This way I can measure the radio frequency radiation emitted by your cell phone tower, I will let you know when I have decided on which one - or you can ship one to me. Thanks!

* Difference in property selling value with cell tower close and the actual value. Guess what? Research says and my Real Estate agent states that our property decreases 20%. While the DeBolts, owners of cell tower property, receives anywhere from \$100 - \$5000 monthly. Not fair!

* Will you pay us for the above or a monthly allowance for our increase for living if the tower

is constructed? Only fair!

So you think - Just take the 20% loss and move. My husband is 75 now and moving the business is not an option. Also, we didn't purchase this property of 53 acres for me to reside in a metal clad house the rest of my life just on my floor of 1750 sq ft. Yes, I'd be able to look outside briefly when I pulled back my recently installed RF/EMF Blocking drapes. But I bet our wildlife will be gone, and the bees that pollinate my organic garden will be gone. No more walking, mowing or gardening due to radiation from your tower! Bear in mind, if I start feeling the affects of RF exposure then I will need to move. My husband says he will not move! So after being married for almost 30 years a divorce is in my ^{near} future? I am freaked out - what will I do?

To conclude, here in Western Kentucky we live a simple life - no Wi-Fi or computer. I love being able to go right out my front door and go for my walks in our woods. Also, working in my organic container garden gives me peace and joy to grow healthy vegetables to nourish my body and soul. I even love to sit on my Bad Boy and mow with an attitude! (My husband appreciates that because he hates mowing.)

Due to his age, I know that eventually we will no longer have the business. However, his shop is in the valley, across the creek, and he will still enjoy going down there. But all of this can be taken away from us due to the radiation from the cell tower.

My whole life I've dealt with health issues, and I believe that now at age 64, I'm getting better. Please allow me to finally regain my health and

and also (accidentally being shot, brown recluse bite and other things)

live the rest of my life here on
Capp Springs. On behalf of myself
and my husband with health issues,
and all of our neighbors with present
and potential future health issues
PLEASE do not construct the
cell tower on the Fairdealing West
site Docket # 2025-00028.
